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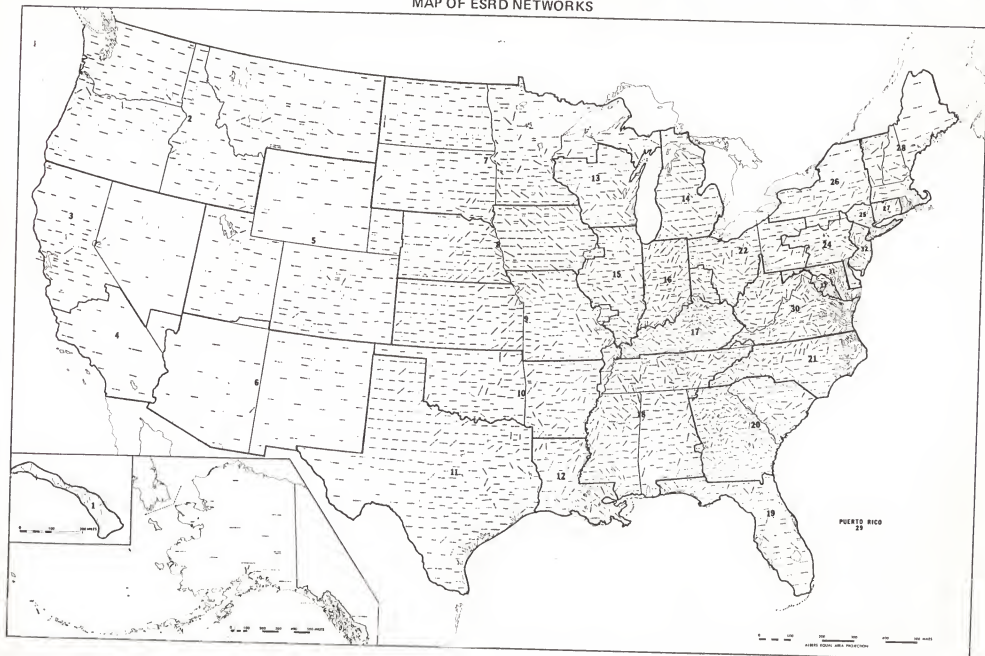

FACILITY REPORT NO. 2 MEDICARE APPROVED ESRD SUPPLIERS

INTRODUCTION

This is the second in the series of reports on the nation's Medicare-approved End-Stage Renal Disease (ESRD) facilities. The report covers the period from January 1, 1976, through December 31, 1976, and is based upon data collected from the facilities through the mail survey questionnaire which was sent to them during the first week in January 1977.

The reader will note that this report contains a much more extensive compilation of data than the first facility report. The first ESRD Facility Survey was intended primarily as a vehicle for verification of nationwide ESRD data collection procedures and as a limited source of data for network and national level program planning and development purposes. It served a further important purpose in familiarizing providers of ESRD care with the survey process and the specifics of the information being collected. Thus the groundwork was laid for an improved level and accuracy of reporting for the second ESRD Facility Survey. This, in turn, has made possible a much more detailed presentation of data in the present report.

The principal categories of information reported are:

1. Operating patterns and services,
2. Ownership and affiliation,
3. Patient census,
4. Utilization data,
5. Staffing patterns, and
6. Transplantation activity

The statistical tables have been grouped accordingly for the convenience of the reader. As in the case of its predecessor, the most immediate purpose of this report is to present basic facility information for use in ESRD Program planning and development activities at local, state, and national levels. This purpose has acquired additional urgency with the recent funding of the ESRD Network organizations which will now assume full operational status. A slightly less immediate, but no less important, purpose of these data is to provide a basis for various analytical studies that will provide a clearer understanding of the patterns of delivery of ESRD services.

This report is primarily statistical in nature in keeping with its purpose as a source of data for program planning, development and administration. For some users, who seek more general information about ESRD Facilities and services, there may be considerably more detail than necessary. This report does not attempt to engage in extensive interpretation of the data presented. The task of interpretation is complex and requires detailed knowledge and understanding of differing local situations and conditions. It is not possible to adequately address such material here. Therefore, interpretive reports will be prepared on a selective basis at appropriate times in the future in order to meet the various needs for such information.

In this report survey data are aggregated at the network and national levels. This format accommodates the needs of the widest circle of users of these data. However, the ESRD Medical Information System has capabilities for reports with other aggregations of the data, e.g., Network by Facility and State by County breakdowns. These additional series of Facility Reports address themselves to the particular needs of the Network Coordinating Councils and state, local, and regional health planning organizations.

SOURCES AND LIMITATIONS OF THE DATA

The long-term ESRD Program, which became effective on September 1, 1976, established certain conditions that suppliers of ESRD services were required to meet in order to be eligible for participation and Medicare reimbursement. One of these conditions requires ESRD suppliers to submit data concerning their facilities, services, and patients to the national ESRD MIS. In order to maintain a uniform and comprehensive body of information relating to facilities and services, the ESRD Facility Survey is conducted each year by the ESRD MIS. The survey is designed to collect data on a calendar year basis. Distribution of the survey questionnaire to facilities is timed to coincide with the end of the calendar year when most facilities are compiling their normal year-end reports.

The ESRD Facility Survey questionnaire accompanied by a detailed instruction manual and a transmittal letter containing supplemental instructions was mailed to 895 facilities on January 5, 1977. These were facilities that were listed with the ESRD MIS, at that time, as participating in the interim program. Of the 895 forms mailed, 854 were returned in time to be processed for preparation of this report. Responses from 52 of these facilities are not included in this report since they stated that they (1) were not operational during the survey period, (2) provided acute inpatient (hospital) dialysis only (i.e., were not operating a chronic maintenance dialysis program), or (3) were not participating in the ESRD Program at the time of the survey. No response had been received from 41 facilities by the time processing for the report had begun. Thus, this report presents data for a total of 802 facilities.

Table A below presents these data for the nation and for each of the 32 networks. The table shows the number of facilities approved by the Medicare Program to provide ESRD services and also the number of approved stations they operate. The section of the table covering facilities not included in the report also indicates in parentheses the number of stations associated with those facilities. This is done for the benefit of those readers who may wish to use data from this report in making computations which involve stations. A further set of data presented in the table covers the 789 facilities for which complete station and patient information was available. There were 13 facilities for which critical patient and/or station data

were not available, thereby excluding them from presentation in many of the tables in this report, e.g., patient census, utilization of stations, etc.

The survey has an effective date of December 31, 1976. However, it is important to note that there are three distinct time frames associated with the collection and reporting of the survey data. First, there are many items which reflect the status of the facility or its operations at a single instant in time, e.g., patient census, facility location, etc. Second, there are items which measure an amount of activity taking place in the whole week nearest the end of the year, for example, hours and days of operation or number of treatments given. Third, some items are concerned with a quantitative measure of an activity over the entire year, such as the number of transplants performed or the number of patients trained.

It is essential that the reader be aware that the number of facilities reported in the various tables in this report differ and of the reasons for these differences. Of the 802 facilities included in this report not all are included in each of the tables. This occurs because some facilities either did not provide the services being tabulated or did not submit the data necessary for inclusion in a specific table. In such cases they are not included in the "Number of Facilities Reporting" column. For example, Table 22, "Transplants Reported for the Period January 1, 1976 - December 31, 1976," shows 145 facilities reporting, 657 fewer than the 802 included in the survey. The difference results from the fact that only 18 percent of Medicare-approved ESRD facilities furnish transplant services.

Care should be taken in the computation and interpretation of summary statistics such as averages, rates, etc., directly from the aggregate data provided in this report because individual reporting facilities may not have been operational for the entire report period. Some facilities may have experienced changes in the number of stations or other operating characteristics. Accordingly, the computation of derived statistics such as those mentioned above should incorporate a weighted contribution for each reporting facility based on its period and level of operation. Although the number of such facilities in a single network may be small, this factor must be taken into consideration in the further analysis of these data.

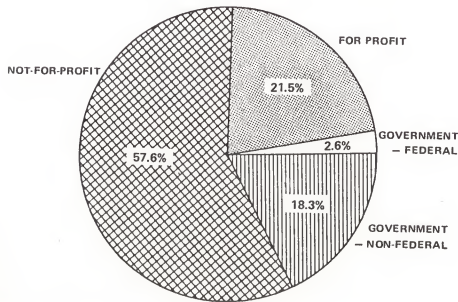
DISCUSSION OF SELECTED FACILITY CHARACTERISTICS

There have been many requests for summary information covering various characteristics of the nation's ESRD facilities. Three of these characteristics have been selected for brief graphic presentation at this time. These items include ownership of ESRD dialysis facilities, staffing patterns in dialysis and transplant facilities, and treatment settings of dialysis patients.

OWNERSHIP

Dialysis facilities have been divided into four main ownership categories; for profit and not-for-profit in the private sector, and federal or non-federal government in the public sector. At the time of the survey, as Figure 1 illustrates, 79.1 percent of ESRD facilities

were located in the private sector, whereas 20.9 percent were affiliated with various governmental jurisdictions. Comparison of these national averages with Table 6, which presents a breakdown of type of ownership by network, reveals pronounced variance of ownership patterns in different areas of the country. In some cases these patterns resemble similar data for short-term acute hospitals in the same geographic areas. In other areas the patterns of ownership of ESRD facilities do not appear to closely resemble those of other health care facilities. A more detailed treatment of these data will be reserved for future reports.

STAFFING PATTERNS

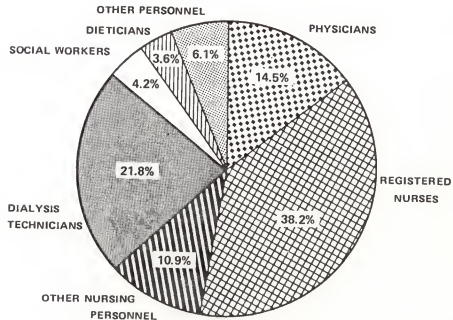
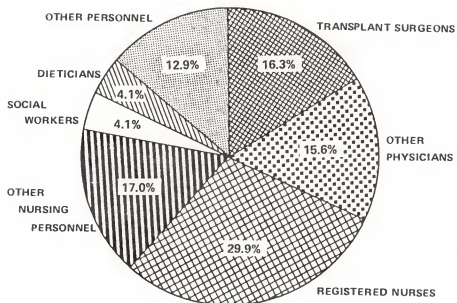


FIGURE 3. STAFFING IN ESRD TRANSPLANT FACILITIES

Figure 2 shows the distribution of staff by specialty for ESRD dialysis facilities nationally. Figure 3 shows similar information for

FIGURE 2. STAFFING IN ESRD DIALYSIS FACILITIES

ESRD transplant facilities. In dialysis facilities nursing personnel and dialysis technicians comprise 70.9 percent of the staff, physicians 14.5 percent, and other types of personnel 13.9 percent. In transplant facilities 31.9 percent or nearly one third of the staff is physicians, 46.9 percent is nursing personnel, and 21.1 percent represents other types of personnel.

By referring to Tables 19, 20, and 21 the differences in average staffing pattern between networks may be studied. There will also be differences in these patterns as a function of facility size but a detailed analysis of such relationships will be reserved for future reports.

TREATMENT OF SETTINGS OF DIALYSIS PATIENTS

The distribution of dialysis patients among the various treatment settings is presented in Figure 4. Complete patient data was available for 789 facilities. As of December 31, 1976, services to

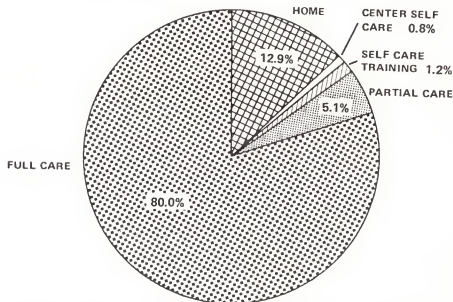
patients were being provided by these facilities as follows:

Full-care patients	755 facilities
Partial-care patients	129 facilities
Self-care patients	50 facilities
Home patients supported	315 facilities

It should be noted that 268 facilities offered self-care training programs but only 119 had patients in training at this time.

Technical Note: In reviewing the data regarding home dialysis patients, it should be noted that the second ESRD Facility Report includes Medicare-approved ESRD facilities only. The Veterans Administration cares for a substantial number of patients in the home dialysis setting who are not included in the ESRD figures. Therefore, when considering the percentage of all end-stage renal patients nationally, the proportion of home dialysis patients may be larger than would seem to be indicated by this report. A detailed examination of data relating to the home dialysis setting is being actively pursued at the present time.

SUMMARY

In reviewing the various tables the reader should be aware that a number of abbreviations and specialized terms have been used to conveniently present the data. In order to assist the reader in interpreting such material, this report contains a list of abbreviations used and a glossary of those terms which may need clarification to promote a uniform understanding of their meaning. In addition, the survey questionnaire and appropriate sections of the ESRD MIS Instruction Manual and Annual Survey transmittal letter have been included as appendices II, III, and IV.

The objective of the ESRD Medical Information System is to provide a base of information that will assist in providing patients

with end-stage renal disease a proper type and level of care and to encourage proper distribution and effective utilization of ESRD services. Corollary goals are maintaining the flexibility of the renal care delivery system and at the same time improving the quality of care. In order to achieve these objectives and yet not overburden the facilities with excessive paperwork, the survey elements were designed specifically to identify the services that are presently available, the manner in which resources are being applied, and the level at which facilities currently function with respect to the patient population presently served.

It is hoped that each user of this report will find it both informative and useful. Reports on the many other aspects of the ESRD Program will be issued on a frequent basis to provide a timely source of information on the providers and recipients of renal health care.

APPENDIX I - GLOSSARY OF TERMS

The items appearing in this glossary are intended to assist the reader by supplying operational definitions of the terms used in the tables and narrative portions of this report.

- Administration - The type of management of a facility. See: University Hospital Administered, Non-University Hospital Administered, and Non-Hospital Administered.
- Approved Dialysis Stations - The number of dialysis stations for which the facility has been approved by the Medicare Bureau, Health Care Financing Administration.
- Average Patients per Staff - Computed for the facility or aggregation of facilities as number of patients divided by the number of full-time equivalent staff members for each of the designated categories of staff.
- Average Staffing Patterns - The number of persons in each type of staff position who administer care to ESRD patients.
- Average Treatments per Station per Week - The number of treatments divided by the number of stations in a facility or aggregation of facilities for the week ending January 2, 1977.
- Cadaveric Kidneys Obtained at the Facility - The number of kidneys which were obtained from deceased donors at the facility.
- Cadaveric Transplant - The kidney that was transplanted was obtained from a deceased donor.
- Census - A count of the ESRD patient population as it existed on December 31, 1976.
- Chronic Maintenance Dialysis - Dialysis which is regularly furnished to an ESRD patient in either a hospital-based, non-hospital based or home setting.
- Chronic Maintenance Dialysis Stations - A configuration of equipment and space which has been approved by the Medicare Program for rendering dialysis to a patient.
- Current Level - The number of dialysis treatments during the week ending January 2, 1977, by a facility or aggregation of facilities.
- Days in Operation - The number of days during the week ending January 2, 1977, that a facility maintained staff and was open to perform services for ESRD patients.
- Days Operating Per Week - See: Days in Operation.
- Dialysis - A process of maintaining the chemical balance of the blood when the kidneys have failed, specifically a process by which dissolved substances are removed from a patient's body by diffusion from one fluid compartment to another across a semi-permeable membrane. The two types of dialysis currently used in common clinical practice are hemodialysis and peritoneal dialysis.
- Dialysis Facility - See: Renal Dialysis Facility.
- Dialysis Treatments - The number of treatments performed for ESRD patients.
- Disposition of Cadaveric Kidneys - The acquisition of cadaveric kidneys and their final disposition.
- End-Stage Renal Disease (ESRD) - That stage of renal impairment which is irreversible and permanent and requires dialysis or kidney transplantation to ameliorate uremic symptoms and maintain life.
- ESRD Facility - In the generic sense, a supplier of health care services that is approved to furnish at least one specific ESRD service.
- ESRD Network - An approved organized group of ESRD facilities in a designated area which, by their type and location and because of local referral patterns, collectively furnish the necessary care for ESRD patients in the population served.

- ESRD Service - The type of care or services furnished to an ESRD patient, such as transplantation or dialysis services.
- Facility - Used in the generic sense to mean any supplier of health care services that is approved by the Medicare Program to furnish dialysis or transplant services.
- Facility Administration - The type of administrative management of the facility.
- Facilities Estimate of Maximum Capability - See: Potential Treatment (Operating) Level.
- Facility Location - The place or site where a facility physically maintains its operation (without regard to type of administration). For example, if a facility occupies a suite of rooms within a hospital building or complex it is "hospital based" but if it occupies a suite of rooms in an office building across the street from the hospital it would be "non-hospital based".
- Full Care - A dialysis setting in which the patient does not perform any substantive tasks as part of his treatment. All services are performed for the patient by professional staff. Patients who do no more than weigh themselves, clean their access site, take their own temperature, or who perform other similar tasks are included in this category.
- Government - See: Type of Ownership.
- Hemodialysis - A method of dialysis in which blood from a patient's body is circulated through an external device or machine and thence returned to the patient's bloodstream. Such an artificial kidney machine usually is designed to remove fluids and metabolic end products from the bloodstream by placing the blood in contact with a semipermeable membrane which is bathed on the other side by an appropriate chemical solution referred to as dialysate.
- Home Patients - Those patients who maintain their own dialysis equipment at home and perform their own treatment alone or with the assistance of a helper.
- Hospital Based - The facility is physically located within the hospital building or complex.
- Hours in Operation - The number of hours during the week of January 2, 1977, for which a facility maintained staff and was open to perform services for ESRD patients.
- Inpatient Dialysis - Dialysis which, because of medical necessity, is furnished to an ESRD patient on a temporary inpatient basis in a hospital.
- Living Related Transplants - The donor of the kidney that was used for the transplant was a living blood (genetic) relative of the donor.
- Location - See: Facility Location.
- Medical Information System - A system which contains medical information on patients and the services that they have received during the course of their therapy. The ESRD medical information system is an automated system of medical records which deals primarily with current Medicare eligible ESRD patients but also maintains historical information on persons no longer classified as ESRD patients by reason of death or successful transplantation.
- Non-Hospital Administered - The facility is an autonomous unit not operated as a department or service of a hospital.
- Non-Hospital Based - Refers to those facilities which are not physically located within a hospital building or complex.
- Non-Profit, Non-Government - See: Type of Ownership.
- Non-University Hospital Administered - The facility is operated as a department or service of a hospital which is not part of, or administratively operated by, a university.
- Number of Dialysis Treatments Given - The number of times dialysis machines were used to provide patient treatments.

Number of Facilities by Number of Transplants - The number of facilities performing a specified number of transplants for the reporting period.

Number of Facilities Reporting - The number of facilities which were Medicare approved and operational that provided the specific data needed to produce a given table.

Number of Operating Hours - The number of hours in a week a facility is open to provide ESRD patient services.

Number of Patients Dialyzed - The number of individual patients for whom dialysis treatments were provided.

Number of Patients Trained - The actual number of patients who have completed a certified training program teaching them to perform their own renal dialysis treatments in the home or on an outpatient basis alone or with the assistance of a helper.

Number of Treatments Provided - The number of dialysis treatments being performed during the facilities normal operating schedule.

Outpatient Self-Care - See: Self Care. The type facility where a patient goes to receive ESRD services and then returns home upon completion of the treatment.

Ownership - See: Type of Ownership.

Partial Care - A dialysis setting in which the patient participates in his treatment under the direction and assistance of professional staff. Patients who perform such complex tasks as assisting in setting up dialysis equipment, inserting fistula needles and initiating dialysis, monitoring blood pressure or other vital signs throughout dialysis, and assisting in terminating the dialysis treatments are included in this category.

Patient-Staff Ratio - Computed as the number of patients per staff member of designated type in a facility (or group of facilities).

Patients Treated - The types of patients treated at a particular facility according to age groupings, such as, children, those under 16

years of age, and a facility that treats patients of all ages.

Peritoneal Dialysis - A procedure which introduces dialysate into the abdominal cavity to remove waste products through the peritoneum (a membrane which surrounds the intestines and other organs in the abdominal cavity). It functions in a manner similar to that of the (artificial) semipermeable membrane in the hemodialysis machine.

Potential Operating Level - The maximum number of treatments which could be provided by a facility without altering the existing mode of operation (i.e., increasing number of stations or changing the current method or length of dialysis treatments).

Profit Making - See: Type of Ownership.

Renal Dialysis Center - A hospital unit which is approved to furnish the full spectrum of diagnostic, therapeutic (including patient dialysis furnished directly or under arrangement) and rehabilitative services, except renal transplantation, for the care of ESRD dialysis patients.

Renal Dialysis Facility - A unit which is approved to furnish dialysis services to ESRD patients.

Renal Transplant Center - A hospital unit which is approved to furnish direct transplantation and other medical and surgical specialty services required for the care of the ESRD transplant patients, including inpatient dialysis furnished directly or under arrangement.

Self-Care - The patient has been trained in dialysis techniques and dialyzes himself in a dialysis facility without professional assistance. Patients who are entirely responsible for administering their own dialysis treatments without professional support (except for emergency situations) are included in this category.

Self-Care Training - A program which trains ESRD patients or their helpers, or both, to perform self-care dialysis.

Services Provided - Those services provided to ESRD patients, such as dialysis and transplantation.

Setting - The type and location of the dialysis treatment being performed, i.e., full care, partial care, self-care, self-care training and home patients.

Stations - See: Approved Dialysis Stations.

Suppliers - For the purpose of the ESRD MIS, a supplier of services in the ESRD Program is a facility that has been approved by the Medicare Program to furnish at least one specific ESRD service.

Total Staff per Facility - The number of full-time equivalent personnel providing services to patients in an ESRD facility.

Transplant - Refers to the number of kidney transplant operations performed, not necessarily to the number of individuals receiving a transplant. Unless otherwise specified, entries in this category include both live and cadaveric donor sources.

Transplant Facility - A facility in which transplant procedures are performed.

Transplantation Service - A process by which a kidney is excised from a live or cadaveric donor and then implanted in an ESRD patient. Supportive care is furnished to the recipient (and to a living donor) following implantation.

Transplants Performed - The number of kidneys transplanted by

source type; i.e., living related or cadaveric.

Transplants Reported - The number of transplants that were reported by the individual facilities, in this survey, as having been performed by them during the indicated reporting period.

Type of Ownership - The legal entity which owns or controls the capital resources of the facility, e.g., individual proprietorship, corporation, governmental jurisdiction. The basic categories are (1) for-profit, (2) not-for-profit-nongovernment, (3) government-non-federal, or (4) government-federal.

Type of Patients Treated - The age group of patients being treated at a particular facility (age 16 or less or patients of all ages).

Type of Services Provided - A specification of the nature of services or treatments provided to ESRD patients, (i.e., dialysis, transplantation, or both).

University Hospital Administered - The facility is operated as a department or service of a hospital which is part of, or administratively operated by, a university.

Utilization of Dialysis Stations - The overall usage of dialysis stations during the week ending January 2, 1977. It is expressed as the average number of treatments per station. This is obtained by dividing the total number of treatments performed by the number of chronic dialysis stations for a facility or aggregation of facilities.

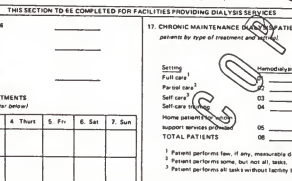

Prior to implementing the PMTS we will be collecting data which define both the facility and patient population on December 31, 1976, in order to establish the baseline against which all subsequent measurements are to be made. These basic master files are being assembled in two ways. First, is the direct transfer of SSA Medicare files to the ESRD MIS, augmented by historical data obtained from the American College of Surgeons' Renal Transplant Registry and the Research Triangle Institute's National Dialysis Registry. Second, the completeness and accuracy of our file will be increased by having each treatment facility (1) complete the initial set of the ESRD MIS annual follow-up forms and (2) verify the status of each of its patients as it appears in our file.

The enclosed forms are the routine annual data collection instruments which will be used by the ESRD MIS to follow the status of home dialysis and transplant patients; to assess the health and rehabilitation status of the ESRD population; to measure the level of dialysis-associated hepatitis; and to define the operating level of dialysis and transplantation programs participating in the ESRD Medicare program. Detailed instructions for completing the ESRD Transplant Patient Follow-up Report (HSA-600-3); ESRD Home Dialysis Patient Follow-up Report (HSA-600-4); ESRD Patient Health and Rehabilitation Survey (HSA-600-6); and the ESRD Facility Survey (HSA-600-5) appear in the enclosed Instruction Manual. Since most facilities have just recently completed a Facility Survey Report (HSA-600-5), we have modified the instructions, as described below, to eliminate those items which need not be reported again at this time. An addendum to the Instruction Manual containing detailed instructions for the National Surveillance of Dialysis-Associated Hepatitis questionnaire (CDC 4.534) is also enclosed.

NOTE: It is particularly important that you be as accurate as is possible when completing Items 19 and 25, which relate to hepatitis cases during calendar year 1976. These data will be used by the Center for Disease Control as an integral part of their national surveillance of dialysis associated hepatitis, described below. We recognize that in some facilities the hepatitis data requested may not be readily available, but at the same time believe that it is of such importance that you should take whatever steps are necessary to report it at this time.
