## Attempt to Extort \$6,500 From Farmer Near Pinckneyville

**LEAVE NOTE DEMANDING  
HE PUT THAT AMOUNT IN  
MAIL BOX OF RURAL HOME**

State and county authorities today sought the person or persons who attempted to extort \$6,500 from Adam Englehardt, farmer residing south of Pinckneyville, according to Police Lieutenant Edwin Kleeman.

A typewritten note which Englehardt found in his rural mailbox yesterday morning demanded that he leave that amount in the box or "be sorry."

The note, now in the hands of the state's attorney, was prepared on tablet paper, authorities said.

The case does not appear to be the work of a "professional extortionist" according to one official.

A car parked in the area of the Englehardt home, which is situated near Pyramid mine, has been investigated and its owner exonerated, an authority said.

The machine was the property of a resident of a northern Illinois city and his whereabouts at the time the note was apparently deposited in the Englehardt box has been ascertained.

## Trace Extortion Case Through Call To Du Quoin Depot

A threatening telephone call was apparently their only new clue today as state police continued their investigation of an attempt to extort \$6,500 from Adam Englehardt, Pinckneyville farmer.

Operators here traced the call, received in the Englehardt home Saturday afternoon, to a public telephone located in the Du Quoin Illinois Central Railroad depot, police said.

Operators were able to trace the call through tickets which are made on each pay station usage and filed at the local exchange, according to telephone officials.

The tickets give only the name of the party being called, however. Operators do not ask for the name of the person placing the call since tolls are deposited on the spot and no charge made.

Sheriff Emil Boquillon said his office has no new developments in the case and that it is "leaving it up to state police."

State's Attorney Harold Farmer said he had not been advised of any new clues or any further developments.

Englehardt told authorities he found a typewritten note demanding \$6,500 in the mailbox at his rural home Friday morning.

The note advised him to place the money in the mail box or "be sorry."

## REPORTS NO NEW DEVELOPMENTS IN EXTORTION CASE

Police today continued their search for the person or persons who attempted to extort \$6,500 from a Pinckneyville farmer, but reported no new developments.

A note demanding that amount was reported found in the mail box of Adam Englehardt Friday morning. The following day police traced a threatening telephone call received at the Englehardt home and found it had been placed from a toll phone at the Illinois Central depot here.

## FOUR MILE FARMER DIED OF INJURIES RECEIVED OCT. 1

### Adam Englehardt Succumbs Friday; Interment Occurred Saturday.

Adam John Englehardt, one of this county's most prosperous farmers, died at his home south of this city, last Friday morning at 2:15, after a few days illness, caused from an accident while drilling wheat. Mr. Englehardt was working with the drill and was in the act of pulling down the lever, when it relaxed and struck him in the stomach, causing his death later. The accident occurred Tuesday morning and Wednesday Drs. Gillis and McCandless performed an operation in the hope of saving his life. The operation relieved the patients suffering, but the wound was too great for him to withstand.

The deceased was born in Bischofswind Bayern Germany, August 18, 1856, and he came to this country when but 16 years of age. He located in St. Clair county, Illinois with his parents. He was married to Dorothy Kenzler in 1884, and to this union nine children were born, seven boys and two girls. They are Edward Conrad, Frederick, Herman, William, John, Meta, Adam, Jr. and Mrs. William Schorn. Besides his nine children, a wife and two grandchildren and a host of friends are left to mourn his departure.

At the time of his death he was 56 years, 1 month and 15 days old. He had been a resident of this county since 1886 and made his home on the same farm all these years.

## ROOTS: A GLIMPSE OF HUNKER HISTORY

The name of the earliest one in our recorded Hunker history was HANZ B. HUONKER, born in the late 1590s (?), mayor of Leidringen in central Germany; he was crippled in the THIRTY YEARS WAR.

First to immigrate to America was JOHN HUONKER (6th generation) who came in 1833, settled in Pennsylvania and later moved to Michigan. Because HUONKER was inconvenient for Americans to pronounce, he changed the spelling to HUNKER. Three of his nephews (sons of his brother Joshua) later immigrated: LOUIS (LEWIS) in 1849, JOSHUA, JR. in 1866, and our grandfather, LEONHARD, in 1869. He was the one who settled in Roanoke (7th generation). Census records show that between 1820-1865 1,545,508 German immigrants came to America, so our ancestors were a part of that movement.

LEONHARD married CATHARINE MORLOCK on April 11, 1871 when she was 15 years old. She was a daughter of German immigrants. They had 11 children, one nearly every two years (8th generation), 7 sons and 4 daughters.

The last of these eleven children, AUNT CLARA, died May 14, 1992, only three months before she would have been 100 years old, surpassing UNCLE WILL who had lived to be 97. Our original purpose in having this reunion was to celebrate a bit early her 100th birthday (August 23), and to note the 151st birthday of LEONHARD HUONKER.

Of the eleven children, one died at age 4 (Samuel Leslie), another at age 17 (JOHN MARTIN), two did not have children (No. 2 ALBERT and No. 10, CLARA); and one did not marry (WILL) who lived to be 97 (because he did not have children?).

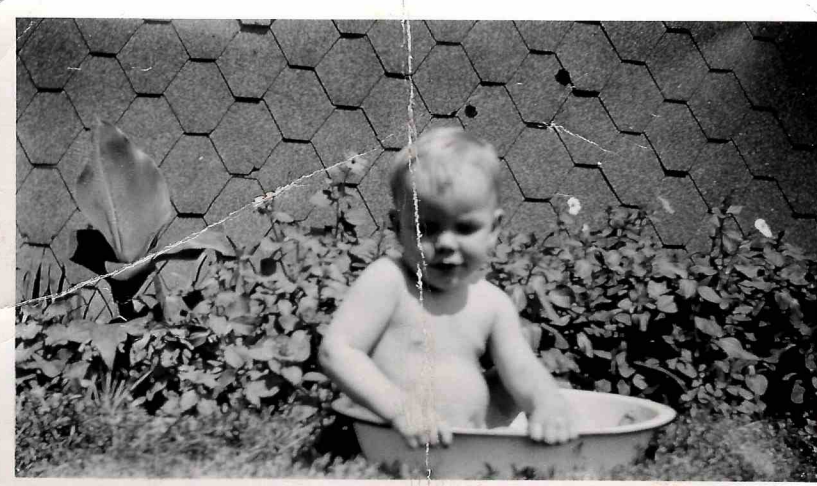

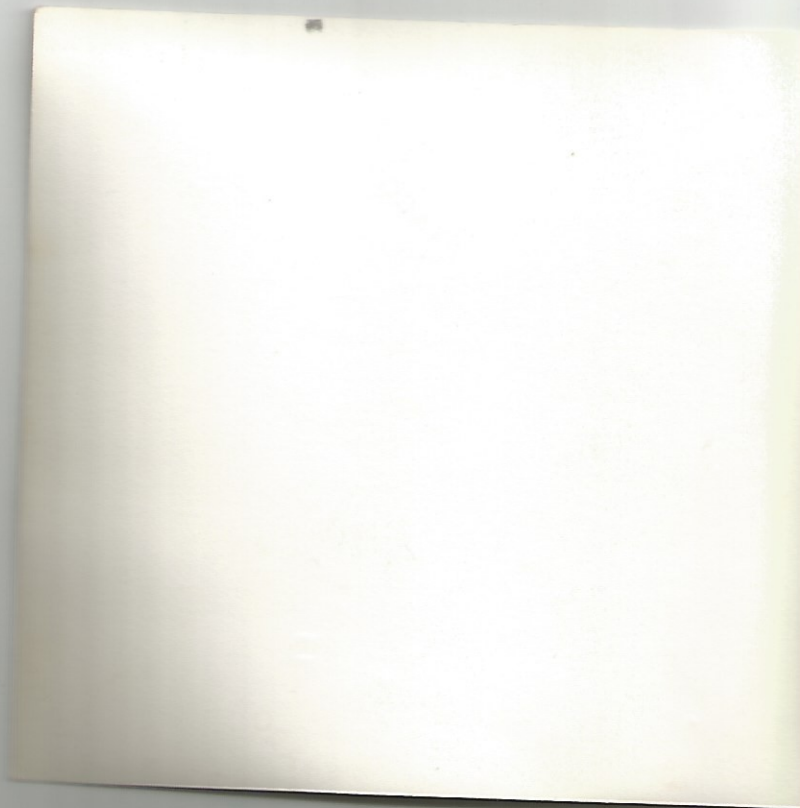

Bess says, "Slim you sure have a pretty little boy". My dad says, "Bess don't tell him that it'll give him the big head". We look west down the highway and we can see the little Maid Rite sign and Little Pete Reidelberger's Shell station down the way. Across the street old Harry Smith is locking up and the Hoffman House is a buzz. The Greyhound bus is in and people are trying to get something to eat. The black people have to take theirs in a sack and eat it outside or on the bus. Charley Saltzman is telling everyone he's getting in the new car business selling Hudsons. Bud Horner has gone to Monmouth and Fuzz Pyatt is going to try it on his own. About the only funerals they had last year was family members as Charlie Doerr seems to have the dead business locked up. Dean Hammack is standing in front of his dry cleaners talking politics and next door Dode Ruppert is taking in the sidewalk displays getting ready to close. Across the alley the Bartles are doing the same. There's Teds daughter Kay and is she a cute thing. Not much happening at the Green Tea Room. Next door old man Pillars and Pickles are standing out front looking down the street wondering why Joe has all the business. About this time Fred Glidewell comes crawling out of the basement looking like the creature from the center of the earth. Turk Dingle stops to talk to Fred as we pass the Illinois Power Office closed for the weekend. Just behind the light office the Gruners are taking in their wares getting ready to close the Maytag shop. Accross the highway Lloyd Edwards, the manager of the old Krogers is getting ready to give Doris Thompson and Ernie Willams their well earned paychecks. The old store with the counter all down the east side smells like fresh ground coffee. Near the back is a freezer where fish are kept and earlier in the day some little kid tried licking the frost on the freon pipe and his tongue stuck to the ice and they had a time getting him loose. Next door at the Sherman House Hotel everyone is in line because Olin Mills is in town and it's picture time. In the little dog house built on the east side of the Sherman House Ren Craig is finishing up his last hair cut. Les Smiley is standing out in front of his dealership saying soon he would have new Fords again after a long dry spell during the war. Around the corner Oscar Krupp has already closed his feed and egg business and is probably next door at Boone Crains. Boones place is a typical tavern where you can drink till you drop if someone don't knock you off your feet first. We continue on and stop to look in Ed Weithorns 5 & 10 store window and would I like to have that Red Rider BB gun in the window! Next door at Hirsch's drygoods store Elmer Pursell has a few customers. My dad tells me "Son right here on this spot is where Frank Stevenson killed Quinn Charlton the sheriff". It seems the sheriff was a little too friendly with Frank's wife. We cross North Main and the Post Office is closed and no more than is upstairs at the Airliner they might as well be also. Next door Maud Gruner of the Gruner Hardware Store is hinting that soon they would be selling televisions like the one Everett Rice had in his tavern. Everetts tavern was behind the old Kroger store next to Bob Hobsons tire shop. Everett didn't allow any rough stuff but there were a lot of slot machines and high stakes pool games. He had a big screen home made TV that



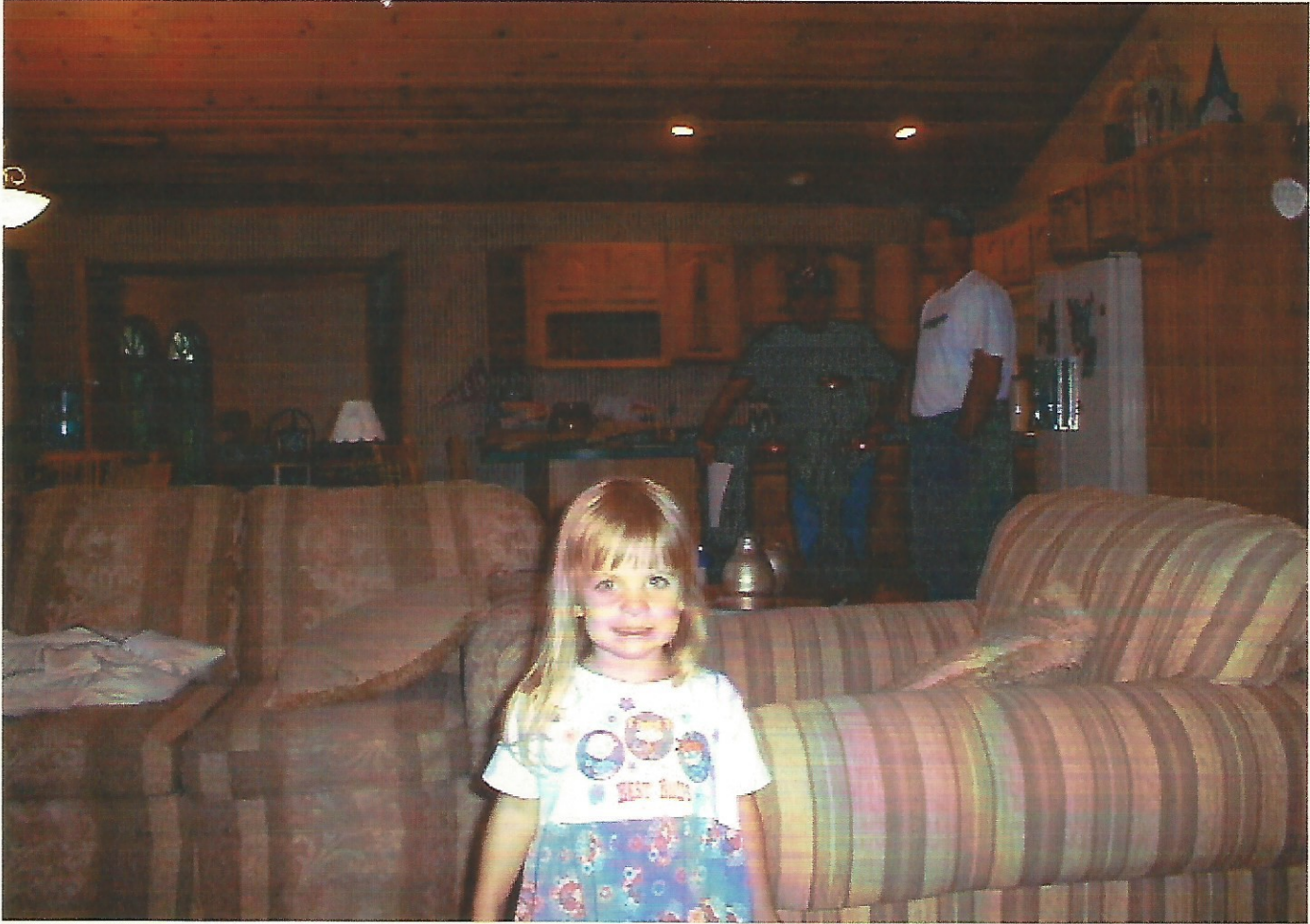
you could watch the fights and hockey games on. Most of the time it looked like they were playing in a snow storm. Next to Gruner Hardware Bud & Mrs. Nesbitt were making their last sale for the day. Across the alley Charley Guemalley had all the shiny Bulova and Elgin watches on display in the window. As we make the final side of the square the Breys, the local scribes, had sent Don Dry home early for acting a little strange. Curt Clippard still had a few customers in the Clover Farm Grocery. ## Attempt to Extort \$6,500 From Farmer Near Pinckneyville

**LEAVE NOTE DEMANDING  
HE PUT THAT AMOUNT IN  
MAIL BOX OF RURAL HOME**

State and county authorities today sought the person or persons who attempted to extort \$6,500 from Adam Englehardt, farmer residing south of Pinckneyville, according to Police Lieutenant Edwin Kleeman.

A typewritten note which Englehardt found in his rural mailbox yesterday morning demanded that he leave that amount in the box or "be sorry."

The note, now in the hands of the state's attorney, was prepared on tablet paper, authorities said.

The case does not appear to be the work of a "professional extortionist" according to one official.

A car parked in the area of the Englehardt home, which is situated near Pyramid mine, has been investigated and its owner exonerated, an authority said.

The machine was the property of a resident of a northern Illinois city and his whereabouts at the time the note was apparently deposited in the Englehardt box has been ascertained.

## Trace Extortion Case Shows Call To Du Quoin Depot

A threatening telephone call was apparently their only new clue today as state police continued their investigation of an attempt to extort \$6,500 from Adam Englehardt, Pinckneyville farmer.

Operators here traced the call, received in the Englehardt home Saturday afternoon, to a public telephone located in the Du Quoin Illinois Central Railroad depot, police said.

Operators were able to trace the call through tickets which are made on each pay station usage and filed at the local exchange, according to telephone officials.

The tickets give only the name of the party being called, however. Operators do not ask for the name of the person placing the call since tolls are deposited on the spot and no charge made.

Sheriff Emil Boquillon said his office has no new developments in the case and that it is "leaving it up to state police."

State's Attorney Harold Farmer said he had not been advised of any new clues or any further developments.

Englehardt told authorities he found a typewritten note demanding \$6,500 in the mailbox at his rural home Friday morning.

The note advised him to place the money in the mail box or "be sorry."

## REPORTS NO NEW DEVELOPMENTS IN EXTORTION CASE

Police today continued their search for the person or persons who attempted to extort \$6,500 from a Pinckneyville farmer, but reported no new developments.

A note demanding that amount was reported found in the mail box of Adam Englehardt Friday morning. The following day police traced a threatening telephone call received at the Englehardt home and found it had been placed from a toll phone at the Illinois Central depot here.

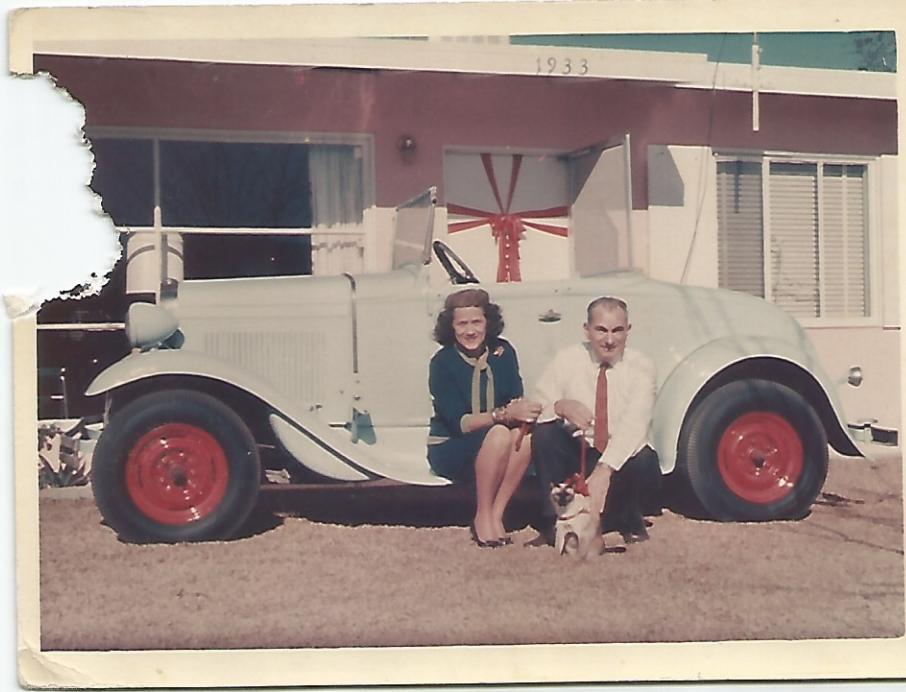

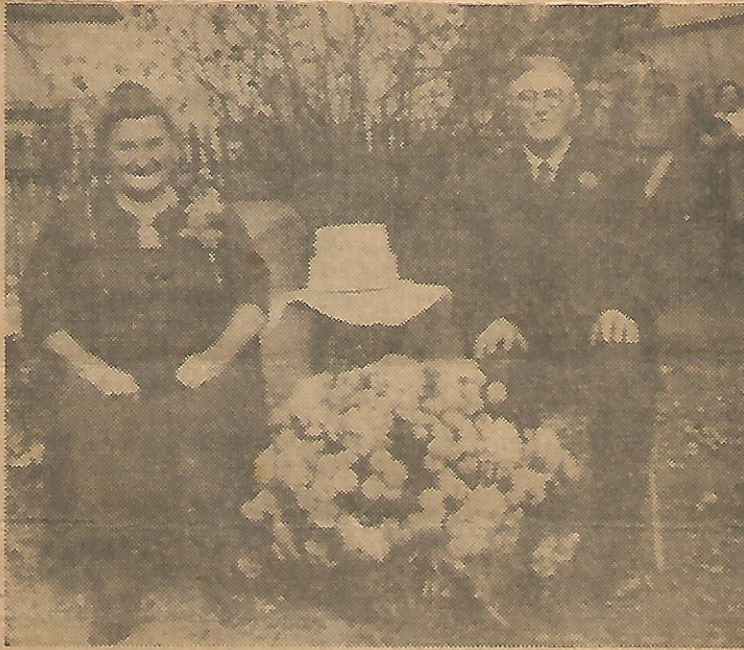
