AMPLIFICATION OF LIVINGSTON MARBLE AND GRANITE WORKS ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT

BACKGROUND

Livingston Marble and Granite Works was issued Operating Permit 00023 in 1972 to quarry travertine on 17.5 acres. The operation consists of four small quarries on the bench northeast of Gardiner. Application for Amendment No. 001 was received on Nov. 13, 1992. This amendment would allow expansion of one of the existing quarries onto an additional 1.4 acres.

PHYSICAL ENVIRONMENT

Topography and Geology: The proposal would create a minor alteration in the local topography. A rise of land approximately 20 feet in height would be mined out, resulting in a gently sloping configuration. This slope would be revegetated.
