# *Allen Genealogy*

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THE Society of Descendants of Walter Allen, incorporated under the laws of Massachusetts, has been organized "to further historical and genealogical research, preserve family records and strengthen family ties." The entrance fee and yearly dues are merely nominal. The officers of the Society are: President, Wm. Henry Allen of Boston, Mass.; Vice-Presidents, Louis Hasbrouck of Ogdensburg, N. Y.; Frederick E. Allen of Turner's Falls, Mass.; J. Harding Allen of Barre, Mass.; Secretary, J. Weston Allen of Boston; Treasurer, Romeo E. Allen of Shrewsbury, Mass.; Historian, Allen H. Bent of Boston.

The progenitor of the family, Walter Allen, settled in Newbury, Essex County, Mass., about 1640, but after 1652 lived in Charlestown and Watertown Farms, now the town of Weston, in the adjoining County of Middlesex. Although the old home-stead in Weston remained in the hands of the family until well into the nineteenth century, other descendants settled in Sudbury, Wayland, Lancaster, Hopkinton, Shrewsbury, Dedham, Concord, Lincoln, Acton, Royalston, Hardwick, Sutton, Northboro, Milford, Rutland, Barre, Petersham, Fitchburg, Hubbardston, Groton, Spencer, Brookfield and Palmer, Mass., Dublin, Hillsboro, Mason and Peterboro, N. H., and Stonington and Montville, Conn.

So many Allens are numbered among the early settlers of New England that the task of locating their descendants is daily increasing in difficulty. Consequently, any one believing himself to be a descendant of the above is invited to put himself in communication with the Society,

Respected relatives: In the year 1884, upon the suggestion of Mary Gifford and others, Isaac B. Tompkins, Jr., issued a circular inviting the descendants of Stephen Allen to meet at the residence of James Gifford in Westport, the present residence of Grandmother Ann D. Allen, September 5, it being her birthday.

The idea of a family gathering was so heartily approved of that a large per cent. of the living descendants of Stephen Allen responded to the invitation, and greatly enjoyed what proved to be the first annual assembling of the Stephen Allen family and their descendants. At this meeting it was unanimously voted to organize with a view of continuing the gatherings annually, and Isaac B. Tompkins, Jr., was chosen chairman, Mary Gifford secretary, who, with Stephen A. Brownell, were constituted an executive committee to propose and make future arrangements. This committee was instructed to select some person to prepare a historical sketch of Stephen Allen and his descendants, to be presented at the next meeting.

A few months previous to the second meeting, upon urgent solicitation of the other members of the executive committee, I, perhaps unfortunately, consented to make an effort to collect the family record of all the descendants of Stephen Allen. The time which I was able to devote to this purpose being necessarily limited, I appeared at the second annual gathering with an incomplete record. Thanks to your confidence and patience, my labor was approved. I was granted more time, and was requested to continue my research and complete the record, and, if possible, to have it printed and ready for distribution at the next meeting.

I then resolved to collect and compile a correct and complete family record, regardless of individual labor or private interest. I have toiled on with that intention, and that I have not reached entire accuracy in every minor particular is a source to me of some mortification and discouragement.

Persons differently constituted and better qualified for this kind of work may, perhaps, deem it only the pastime of a holiday, but I freely confess that to me it has been a difficult task, exceeding my calculations almost beyond expression; and perhaps no one will be able to comprehend why I found it necessary to devote so many days of perplexing thought and labor to accomplish so little. It may be in part explained by the fact that I had no system of arrangement to copy from, but experimented and studied to evolve some plain and brief method of presenting the various facts connected with the record. I also experienced great difficulty in attempting to avoid all errors in the multitude of dates connected with the births, marriages and deaths occurring in so large a family.

To avoid any error occurring, I obtained permission to delay the printing of it until after the third annual meeting, that its accuracy might be tested by the descendants themselves, while there hearing it read. I took the further precaution to have proofs struck off and sent to heads of families for inspection and correction; and yet, so difficult is it to reach entire perfection, I have found it necessary to attach a small errata sheet. I ask your charitable consideration, hoping that no errors exist except those there noted.

Finally, I wish to say that I have derived much pleasure and a great deal of information and discipline of mind while preparing this record.

I take this opportunity to thank my relatives for their kind cooperation and assistance, without which I could not have accomplished the task.

I also wish to thank those connected with the Mercury Publishing Co., who have shown to me every courtesy and aided me in every way in their power.

He won to himself many true friends, yet having no aspiration for political honor he rejected all offers of official position and remained, as he preferred, a humble citizen. Still his memory is sure to last beyond his generation, and we, his descendants, will take pleasure in relating to our children and grand children the story of our worthy ancestor, whose character we shall proudly refer to as a model worthy of imitation.
