On May 21, 1965, "The New York Times," page 36, column 1, reports under the caption, "Dr. King Examines Rights and Laws," that Martin Luther King attended, spoke and received an award at a dinner - session of the American Jewish Committee's 58th annual meeting at the Americana Hotel, New York City, on the night of May 20, 1965. The award received was the group's American Liberties Medallion Award for exceptional service to the cause of human rights.

The article reports that King emphasized that American Negroes in their civil rights struggle were not "wilfully and frivolously" violating the nation's laws, despite the belief by many people that they were doing exactly that.

King criticized those "goodhearted people" who forgive Negroes "on the ground that they endure appalling grievances." He said that "these people forgive them for misdeeds they are not committing." "Negroes," King said, according to the article, "have never forgotten, even under the crushing burdens of injustice, that they are connected with the larger society; that the roads they may obstruct and the public buildings they picket are used in common by all citizens."

In his address, King said that responsible Negro leadership never approved a protest movement unless it could answer several basic questions.

Among these, according to King, are:

"Do we have a just grievance or is our purpose merely to create confusion for its own sake as a form of revenge?

"Do we have a clear program to relieve injustice which does not inflict injustice upon others, and is that program reasonable and grounded in the ethics and best traditions of our society?"

King then declared that in establishing these conditions "before employing direct action the civil rights movement meets its responsibility to society and fulfills its obligations to democratic principle."

He concluded by stating that "one of the most profound of all results of the Negro upsurge has been its effect upon the youth of the nation."

The article reports that Vice President Hubert Humphrey also attended and spoke at the affair.

Transmitted herewith for the Bureau are nine copies, for Atlanta three copies, and for New York two copies of a letterhead memorandum concerning KING's appearance in Louisville, Ky., on 5/16/65.

As indicated in referenced teletype, subject arrived Louisville at 11:03 A.M., 5/16/65, from Atlanta, and he and a Rev. LEE had reservations on EAL Flight 186, leaving Louisville 6:45 P.M. on 5/16/65. This flight was scheduled to arrive Newark 9:15 P.M. same date. KING and Rev. LEE had reservations on EAL Flight 445 leaving Kennedy Airport, New York, at 11:45 P.M., 5/16/65, arriving Atlanta 12:45 P.M., 5/17/65. These reservations were made at 2:00 P.M., 5/15/65, by Rev. LEE.

b7(c) [redacted], Louisville PD, advised that he had been in charge of security in connection with the visit of Dr. MARTIN LUTHER KING, JR., to Louisville on 5/16/65. He said there were no significant incidents, but that one individual, a [redacted] 23, Negro male, giving an address [redacted], Louisville, Ky., was removed from Zion Baptist Church because he was moving from seat to seat in the church. [redacted] was booked for loitering. He was not armed and had apparently been trying to get a better seat. **B. APPROX.**

A suspicious car was observed in the area of Zion Baptist Church on the afternoon of 5/16/65, and it was reported

The Courier Journal, Louisville, Kentucky, a newspaper of general circulation, on May 17, 1965, reported as follows:

Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr., spoke at a service installing his brother, Reverend A. D. Williams King, as pastor of Zion Baptist Church, Louisville, Kentucky, on May 16, 1965.

King "congratulated Louisville and Kentucky for making 'meaningful strides toward equal opportunity,' calling it (Louisville) 'one of the brightest spots in the border states.'" He added a comment to the effect that Louisville and Kentucky still have a long way to go.

He announced that he planned to carry his civil rights crusade into several unnamed northern cities.

He welcomed the new Kentucky Christian Leadership Conference (KCLC) as an affiliate of the Southern Christian Leadership Conference (SCLC).

He "castigated white Christians--clergy and laity--for making '11:00 A.M. on Sunday morning the most segregated hour of the week.'" He "critized any Negro minister 'who has . . . more religion in his voice than in his life.'"

At a press conference, King stated that his economic boycott against Alabama was quite effective; that "'some' companies have promised to comply by not erecting new plants in Alabama." He declined to identify the companies or say how many.

King was welcomed the here to the city by aldermanic
President Kenneth A. Linder on behalf of the people of Louisville,

\$9,000 from the Rev. J. P. Lyons, a Louisville group set up earlier
this year to aid Alabama civil rights workers.

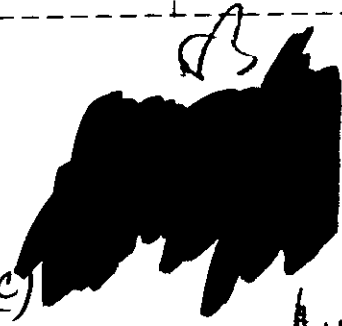

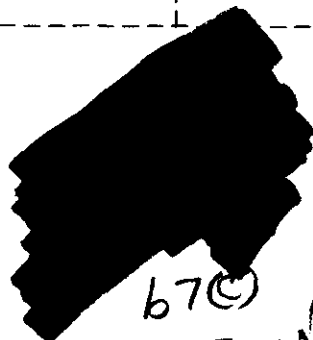

He stated that in 1942 or 1943 he had been introduced to Martha Stone for business reasons. He said he knew Martha Stone to be a Communist Party official.

He said that Martha Stone was to attempt to have the Continental Ballroom manager rent the hall to a social group to which Harris belonged. Harris stated he met Martha Stone in an office on Market Street, in Newark, New Jersey, at that time. to the CP. Harris denied ever attending any CP meetings at the CP Headquarters or any other place and further denied he was ever active in any subversive activity.

Harris stated that he had received the "Daily Worker" at his residence in the 1940's, but denied ever subscribing to the "Daily Worker" or donating any moneys to the "Daily Worker". Harris added that the "Daily Worker" was left at his residence on Sunday mornings by various individuals whom he did not know, and he said he had never met them. Harris also stated he did not know anyone who had ever been active in any subversive activity.

On April 23, 1956, Harris was reinterviewed, at which time he stated that it was possible that he may have signed papers which resulted in his becoming a CP member, but he denied ever attending any CP meetings or acting in any capacity which would be termed as anti-American.

A "Security Investigation Data for Nonsensitive Position" form, dated December 4, 1957, executed by Lenora Harris, Nee May, reveals that on July 12, 1941, at Newark, New Jersey, she married Earl Harris, born January 1, 1918, Dawson, Georgia. Her residence was listed as 382 Badger Avenue, Newark, New Jersey, since June, 1948. From June, 1941 - June, 1948, she resided at 535 Bergen Street, Newark, New Jersey.

At 1:45 p.m., today (5/20/65) Special Agent in Charge Roney of the New York Office telephoned Mr. F. J. Baumgardner at the Bureau to advise of the following information which Roney had just received from [redacted] Americana Hotel, New York City.

At 1:15 p.m., today (5/20/65) a switchboard operator at the Americana received an anonymous call in which the caller only stated "there is a bomb in the hotel." It is noted that Vice President Humphrey is due to arrive at the Americana at 8 p.m. tonight and is scheduled to appear at an affair in the main ballroom. [REDACTED] telephonically contacted the FBI Office, San Antonio, Texas, regarding alleged assassination plan of MARTIN LUTHER KING, JR. related to him by an unknown individual at the [REDACTED] Temple, Texas, earlier that evening.

Attempts to interview [REDACTED] and details concerning the allegation made by him that same evening were conducted with negative results due to his intoxicated condition. It was decided to hold further interview in abeyance until the following morning.

[REDACTED] confidentially advised that evening that her husband frequently becomes intoxicated at which time he misunderstands or misinterprets what people are saying to him. She was of opinion that due to his past behavior little credence should be given to his story.

[REDACTED] was recontacted at which time he advised that at approximately 4:00 PM he went to the [REDACTED] Temple, Texas, and started drinking. After approximately fifteen or twenty minutes an unknown male, approximately 55 to 60 years old, 6' tall, short gray-black hair, 190 to 200 pounds, wearing an old flannel shirt and khaki pants, came into the bar and sat next to him. After a few minutes MOORE started talking to this individual about Texas and other topics. After a few minutes this man inquired if [REDACTED] was in the Army at Fort Hood as a member of CID (Criminal Investigation Detachment). [REDACTED] told him that he

was not and "never would be." The other man then began to talk about a "Mr. KING." He said Mr. KING was telling Mr. JOHNSON what to do and that KING would be running the United States next. [REDACTED] then said "no, he'll be stopped before then." The man then asked [REDACTED] if he was acquainted with military artillery and other military weapons and what [REDACTED] qualifications were on them. [REDACTED] told him he could "split a match right down in half." The man then again asked if [REDACTED] was in CID. [REDACTED] replied "No, but I am in CIA." [REDACTED] explained that he was not really in the CIA, but he just said this to string this man along. The man then said "You are from Panama." [REDACTED] replied, "No, I am from Arkansas, but I have been in Panama." [REDACTED] again explained that he was never really in Panama, but he was again stringing this man along. [REDACTED] said he then got disgusted with this man and tried to terminate the conversation. After approximately ten or fifteen minutes the man again spoke to [REDACTED] making some unrecalled remark about KING and KING's assassination. [REDACTED] asked this man if he knew the movements of this "so called Mr. KING." The man replied that he knew every move KING made and the time and place. [REDACTED] replied, "Well if you know all this, and I am the assassinator, what is my possibility of getting out of it after it's did, and how much money is involved." [REDACTED] again explained that he was stringing this man along, but this time in an attempt to develop some information regarding a possible assassination of KING. The man replied that there was no money involved at the present time. [REDACTED] told him, "Well I have to look after the security and welfare of my family. If I did it, I would have to have \$50,000 and a way out." The man said there was a way out, but no money.

[REDACTED] advised that at this point the man went to the men's room, and he, [REDACTED], started to leave the club. As he was leaving he asked the man how he could get in touch with him and this man replied "I'm here all the time." [REDACTED] said he then immediately went to his home in [REDACTED] and called the FBI in San Antonio requesting that an Agent contact him.

During the course of the above interview [REDACTED] repeatedly changed his story and exhibited great difficulty in recalling what had taken place the evening before. He admitted to having at least five or six beers and to being prone to easy intoxication. [REDACTED] further admitted that during the course of his discussion with the above individual, he steered the conversation toward the possible assassination of KING in an attempt to determine if any such assassination plan existed. He was unsuccessful in doing so.

In view of the above, no further investigation is being conducted by the San Antonio Office of the FBI.

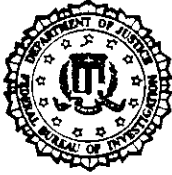

A confidential source, who has furnished reliable information in the past, advised on May 19, 1965, that on that date, Clarence Jones was in contact with Dora McDonald, Secretary to Martin Luther King. Jones' comments included the following:

King wanted him to speak with McDonald concerning some material but understood that King already had received the material for Thursday evening (speech before American Jewish Committee banquet, Hotel Americana, New York City, May 20, 1965). He had been making notes and had gotten together with "my friend", but apparently Bayard Rustin had asked someone to do the work he was unable to do. What Rustin wanted to talk about is different from what he, Jones, and "our friend" were going to talk about.

He, Jones, had had the material described to him and when he realized it was different (from his own) he stopped working on it. The material sent by Rustin was not written by Rustin but Rustin advised what should be included and asked that the material be written from it.

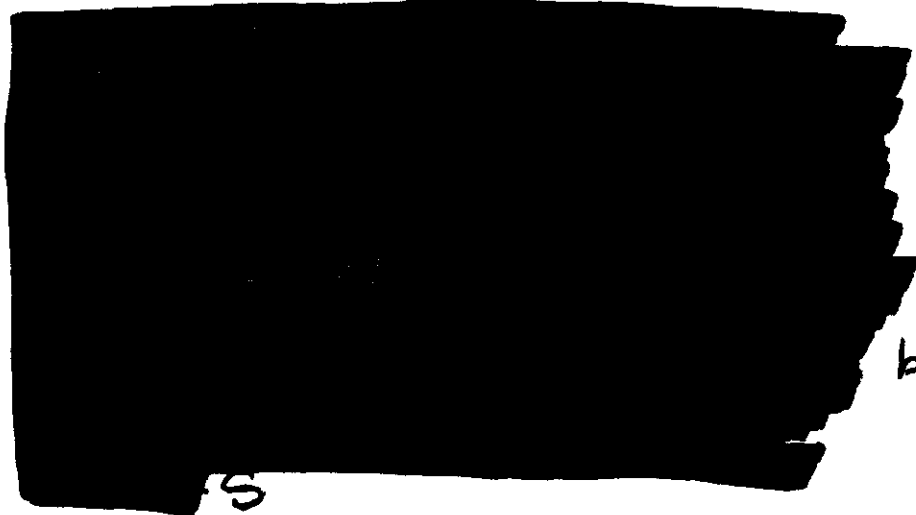

In "The Saturday Evening Post", issue of July 11-18, 1964, page 76, Bayard Rustin is the subject of a feature article captioned: "The Lone Wolf of Civil Rights". In it, Rustin is said to have come to New York in 1938, as an organizer for the Young Communist League (YCL), and as such, he had the job of recruiting students for the "Party". Furthermore, the article reports that during his first years in New York, Rustin gave most of his earnings to the "Party". He reportedly left the "Party" in 1941, the article states.

The YCL has been designated pursuant to Executive Order 10450.

The "Daily Worker", February 11, 1957, page 1 column 2, reported that Bayard Rustin, Executive Secretary, War Resisters League, was an observer at the 16th National Convention of the Communist Party, United States of America (CP, USA), held in New York City, on February 9-12, 1957.

The "Daily Worker" was an East Coast Communist publication until it ceased publication on January 13, 1958.



On May 14, 1965, "The New York Times," Page 23, column 1, reported Martin Luther King's presence at Queens College, New York City, on May 13, 1965. His presence, according to the paper, was the first in an annual series of John F. Kennedy memorial lectures to be presented at the college. His address was before a crowd in excess of 2,200 who filled Colden Auditorium.

The article notes that in his speech, King went from civil rights to broader questions of peace and drew applause when he said he would "never adjust to the madness of militarism" in the world.

"It is either non-violence or non-existence", King declared. He said he wanted to be "as maladjusted as Jesus of Nazarine, who said, in his day, 'He who lives by the sword shall die by the sword'".

"If democracy is to live, segregation must die," King said. "It isn't going to just work itself out", he declared, attacking the "notion that only time can solve this problem" and decrying "The appalling indifference of the good people who sit around waiting on time."

"Time is neutral", King said. "It can be used either constructively or destructively." Not to use it for good, he said, was to cede it to those who would use it for evil."

UNITED KLANS OF AMERICA, INC.
KNIGHTS OF THE KU KLUX KLAN (UNITED KLANS)

Records of Superior Court of Fulton County, Georgia, show that this Klan organization was granted a corporate charter on February 21, 1961, at Atlanta, Georgia, under the name United Klans, Knights of the Ku Klux Klan of America, Inc.

A source advised on February 27, 1961, that United Klans was formed as a result of a split in U. S. Klans, Knights of the Ku Klux Klan, Inc. According to the source, the split resulted from a leadership dispute, and United Klans has the same aims and objectives as the parent group. These are the promotion of Americanism, white supremacy, and segregation of the races.

The first source and second source advised in July 1961, that United Klans, Knights of the Ku Klux Klan of America, Inc., merged with Alabama Knights, Knights of the Ku Klux Klan. The merged organization established headquarters in Suite 401, The Alston Building, Tuscaloosa, Alabama. The organization is directed by ROBERT SHELTON, Imperial Wizard, and is the dominant Klan group in the South with units in several southern states.

On August 14, 1961, the second source advised that the organization formerly known as United Klans, Knights of the Ku Klux Klan of America, Inc., would be known in the future as United Klans of America, Inc., Knights of the Ku Klux Klan. The second source said the name was changed by a resolution adopted at the National Klonvocation held July 8, 1961, at Indian Springs, Georgia.

Second source advised that at a meeting at Prattville, Alabama, on October 22, 1961, a majority of the Klaverns of the U. S. Klans, Knights of the Ku Klux Klan, merged with the United Klans of America, Inc., Knights of the Ku Klux Klan.

On August 17, 1964, a source advised that the North Carolina organization of United Klans of America, Inc., Knights of the Ku Klux Klan, became affiliated with the national organization of the same group in the Spring of 1961. The State Headquarters are at the residence of North Carolina Grand Dragon JAMES ROBERTSON JONES, Granite Quarry, North Carolina, who is subordinate to the national organization with headquarters at Tuscaloosa, Alabama.

The organization in North Carolina has the same aims and objectives as the parent group; that is, advocacy of segregation of the races and white supremacy.

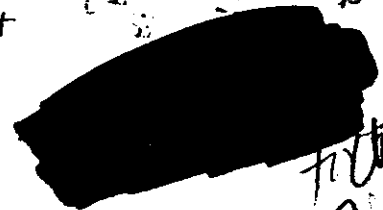

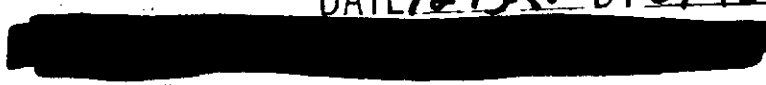

Reurtel 4/20/65 which reported on information obtained from Lovell Dyett of the National Association for the Advancement of Colored People to the effect that his organization had received several telephone calls threatening bodily harm to King. Teletype stated that a letterhead memorandum (LHM) would follow.

Bulet (0-1) 4/27/65 requested advice as to when the LHM would be submitted. Your reply stated "See Boston letter and LHM 4/27/65."

Because the above-referenced communications were in the caption "Martin Luther King, Jr., SM-C" and the Bureau was unable to locate any letter from your office dated 4/27/65 in the King caption, it was necessary to request your office, by routing slip dated 5/11/65, copies of your letter and LHM 4/27/65.

A review of these 4/27/65 communications reveal (1) the LHM does not contain any information pertaining to the threats as reported in your teletype 4/20/65; and (2) your airtel (not letter) 4/27/65 is not in the King caption, thus explaining why the Bureau was unable to locate the correspondence.

You are now instructed to immediately furnish the Bureau, by return airtel, an LHM which will report the original information concerning the threats to King.

It is obvious from the foregoing that this matter was poorly handled from an administrative standpoint in your office. Much delay and needless correspondence has resulted. Form errors should be scored against the responsible personnel, Agent as well as supervisory, and they should be personally impressed with the necessity for exercising greater care in the handling of correspondence with the Bureau in the future.

MARTIN LUTHER KING....AT COMMUNIST TRAINING SCHOOL



The above picture was made by an employee of the State of Georgia, at the Highlander Folk School in Monteagle, Tennessee during the Labor Day week-end of 1957. The photographer was sent to the Highlander Folk School by the Georgia Commission on Education. The Highlander Folk School was abolished by an act of the Legislature of the State of Tennessee at a later date because it was charged with being a subversive organization.

Those numbered in the picture are:

1. Martin Luther King, Jr., of the Montgomery boycott and the Birmingham riots. Karl Prussion, a counterspy for the FBI for twenty-two years, charges that Martin Luther King belongs to sixty Communist-front organizations — more than any Communist in the United States. He is promoted and encouraged by the Kennedys.
2. Abner W. Berry of the Central Committee of the Communist Party.
3. Aubrey Williams, President of the Southern Conference Education Fund, Inc., The Transmission Belt in the South for the Communist Party.
4. Myles Horton, Director of Highlander Folk School for Communist Training, Monteagle, Tennessee.

These "Four Horsemen" of racial agitation have brought tension, disturbance, strife and violence in their advancement of the Communist doctrine of "racial nationalism."

Regarding the individuals you mentioned and your request for a list of reputable speakers, I would like to point out this Bureau is strictly an investigative agency of the Federal Government and, as such, neither makes evaluations nor draws conclusions as to the character or integrity of any organization, publication or individual. In addition, information in our files must be maintained as confidential pursuant to regulations of the Department of Justice and is available for official use only. Therefore, I am sure you will understand why I cannot comment as you desire. 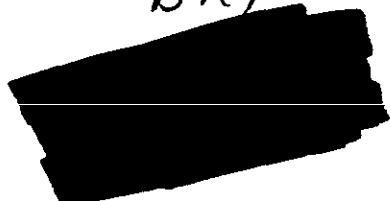
