

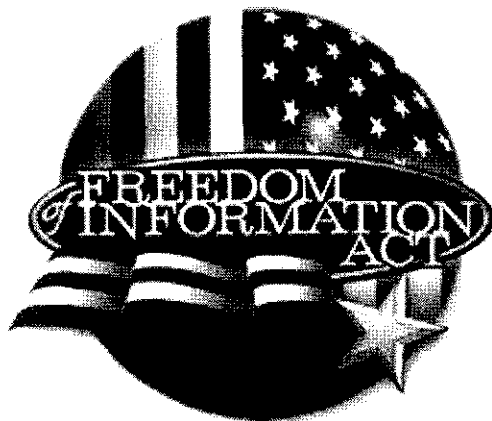

On January 12, 1966, a confidential source, who has furnished reliable information in the past, advised that on that date, Clarence Jones was informed by his secretary that she had been requested by Harry Wachtel to relate that the meeting of the Southern Christian Leadership Conference (SCLC) (Research Committee) meeting scheduled for January 14, 1966, has been cancelled. Wachtel said Jones should be informed that the meeting has been rescheduled for January 19, 1966, in New York City.

On January 10, 1966, a confidential source, who has furnished reliable information in the past, advised that Stanley Levison and Clarence Jones had planned to go to Atlanta, Georgia, on January 14, 1966, and had made airlines reservations for the trip.

1. APPENDIX

NATIONAL LAWYERS GUILD

The "Guide to Subversive Organizations and Publications," revised and published as of December 1, 1961, prepared and released by the Committee on Un-American Activities, United States House of Representatives, Washington, D.C., contains the following concerning the National Lawyers Guild:

"National Lawyers Guild

- "1. Cited as a Communist front.
(Special Committee on Un-American Activities, House Report 1311 on the CIO Political Action Committee, March 29, 1944, p. 149).
- "2. Cited as a Communist front which 'is the foremost legal bulwark of the Communist Party, its front organizations, and controlled unions' and which 'since its inception has never failed to rally to the legal defense of the Communist Party and individual members thereof, including known espionage agents.'
(Committee on Un-American Activities, House Report 3123 on the National Lawyers Guild, September 21, 1950, originally related September 17, 1950.)
- "3. 'To Defend the cases of Communist lawbreakers, fronts have been devised making special appeals in behalf of civil liberties and reaching out far beyond the confines of the Communist Party itself. Among these organizations are the * * * National Lawyers Guild. When the Communist Party itself is under fire these offer a bulwark of protection.'
(Internal Security Subcommittee of the Senate Judiciary Committee, Handbook for Americans, S. Doc. 117, April 23, 1956, p. 91)".

as follows:

A one-day civil rights conference is scheduled to be held in Louisville, Kentucky, on December 16, 1965, primarily for the purpose of obtaining support for the passage of civil rights legislation by the Kentucky Legislature, scheduled to convene in Frankfort, Kentucky, on January 4, 1966. The December 16, 1965, conference is co-sponsored by the Kentucky Conference of the NAACP and the Kentucky Christian Leadership Conference, an affiliate of the Southern Christian Leadership Conference (SCLC). Among scheduled speakers at the conference are the Governor of Kentucky, Ned Breathitt, the Reverend Martin Luther King, Jr., the Reverend C.T. Vivian of the SCLC and James Farmer, Director of the Congress of Racial Equality. Reverend King is scheduled to speak on the evening of December 16, 1965, at the Zion Baptist Church in Louisville, which is pastored by Reverend King's brother, the Reverend A.D. Williams King.

News articles appearing in the December 17, 1965, issue of the Courier-Journal and Louisville Times, daily Louisville, Kentucky, newspapers, and the December 23, 1965, issue of the Louisville Defender, a weekly Louisville, Kentucky, newspaper containing information primarily relating to Negro matters, reported that the December 16, 1965, civil rights conference in Louisville was held as scheduled without any adverse incident having occurred.

In its article regarding the conference, the Louisville Defender reported that Reverend Martin Luther King in his address before the conference had said that the current civil rights revolution is the most important period of change in the nation's history and that Americans must accomplish several goals if the revolution is to succeed. He listed the following: 1) We must reaffirm the immorality of racial segregation, that segregation is not only unsound but morally wrong and sinful. 2) Work passionately and tirelessly to abolish poverty in the nation and the world. 3) Continue to develop mass action programs to get rid of the last vestiges of segregation in America.

It was further reported in the Louisville Defender article that Reverend King brought applause from his audience when he remarked, "It may be true that legislation cannot integrate but it can desegregate... it may not change hearts but change habits of men... it may not make a man love me but it can restrain him from lynching me...well, I think that is pretty important." Further, Reverend King had said that he was alarmed at indications the "war on poverty" may be cut back to finance the war in Vietnam and that should such happen, the United States would win the war in Vietnam and lose the war on poverty in this country. Reverend King urged that it be made clear to the government that "we cannot go back on poverty."

INSTANT:

SCLC ' FIRST SUSTAINED NORTHERN MOVEMENT WILL BE DIRECTED AGAINST PUBLIC AND PRIVATE INSTITUTIONS WHICH HAVE CREATED INFAMOUS SLUM CONDITIONS. MOVEMENT WILL BE MULTI-FACET ASSAULT DIRECTED UNDER AUSPICES OF COORDINATION COUNCIL OF COMMUNITY ORGANIZATIONS AND COMMITTED VETERANS OF SCLC. PRIMARY OBJECTIVE WILL BE UNCONDITIONAL SURRENDER OF FORCES DEDICATED TO CREATION AND MAINTENANCE OF SLUMS AND NOTED CHICAGO IS NOT ALONE WITH SLUM PROBLEM BUT SLUM CONDITIONS IN CHICAGO ARE PROTOTYPE OF THOSE RESPONSIBLE FOR NORTHERN URBAN RACE PROBLEM.

KING NOTED PROBLEMS OF CHICAGO DEMANDED SOMETHING NEW. HE ATTRIBUTED SLUMS TO NEGRO EXPLOITATION IN FIELD OF EDUCATION, BARRING OF NEGROES FROM LABOR UNIONS, RESTRICTION OF HOUSING AVAILABLE TO NEGROES, HIGH INTEREST RATES CHARGED BY BANKS IN DEALING WITH NEGROES, INEFFECTIVE ENFORCEMENT OF BUILDING CODES RESULTING IN HIGH FINANCIAL RETURNS TO SLUM LANDLORDS, THE BREAKDOWN OF FAMILY LIFE THROUGH NEGRO DEPENDENCE ON WELFARE SYSTEM, REFUSAL OF FEDERAL HOUSING AGENCY TO INSURE NEGRO HOME LOANS, POLITICAL INFLUENCE IN COURTS, POLICE CONTEMPT FOR POOR NEGROES, THE ESTABLISHED POLITICAL SYSTEM WHICH DEPRIVES NEGROES OF POLITICAL POWER AND REFUSAL OF CITY ADMINISTRATION TO RENDER ADEQUATE SERVICES TO NEGRO COMMUNITIES.

KING STATED MOVEMENT WILL ACT IN SEVERAL PHASES, COMMENCING JANUARY, NINETEEN SIXTY SIX THROUGH ORGANIZATION AND EDUCATION OF POPULATION TO UNDERSTAND THE "SLUM COLONY", BY INVOLVEMENT OF EVERY

A confidential source, who has furnished reliable information in the past, learned on January 4, 1966, that on that date, Harry Wachtel discussed with Clarence Jones whether a man named Saul (believed to be Saul Mills), would be involved in a conflict of interest if he worked for the Foundation (American Foundation for Nonviolence), as well as for Jones' insurance company, Intramerican Life Corporation. Jones stated that Saul would be working on different people, that he wanted his work by Saul done in the next two weeks.

Wachtel said that he believes there is a conflict of interest, that for Saul to work for the Foundation and raise money for Jones does not sit well with himself. Jones inquired if the conflict was that Saul would be contacting the same people (in his work for the Foundation and Jones). Wachtel told him it was and noted that Saul told him he would work with Jones for one month and then be a consultant for Jones for twelve months.

Wachtel also commented that he has had Martin's (Luther King) permission, for some time, to hire a consultant who would be paid \$10,000 a year.

In concluding their contact, Wachtel inquired of Jones whether he was going to Atlanta on Friday (January 7, 1966). Jones did not answer, prompting Wachtel to say he would take an 8:00 AM United Airlines Flight and will return to Newark that night aboard a Delta Flight.

Later during January 4, 1966, the same source advised that Clarence Jones and an unknown male from Illinois were in discussion on that date concerning a meeting of the Research Committee. Jones said "they" are having the meeting in Atlanta, Georgia, on January 14, 1966, and said it will be from 12:00 Noon until 6:00 PM.

Jones requested the man to attend the meeting, but was told that he (the man) had not been invited by King.

In discussing the meeting further, Jones said Harry Wachtel will attend, and that the American Foundation for Nonviolence will be discussed.

Jones said Judge Ben Hook from Tennessee is President of The Foundation and that he and Harry Wachtel are Board members.

The unknown man said he had learned that King had given the remainder of his Pulitzer Prize money to The American Foundation for Nonviolence.

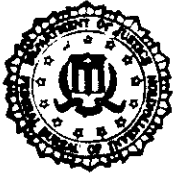

Visit of Martin Luther King, Jr., to

A Negro mass meeting was held at the Harrison Street Baptist Church, Greenville, Alabama, December 6, 1965. The meeting was led by Martin Luther King, who is president of the Southern Christian Leadership Conference (SCLC). King arrived at the Harrison Street Baptist Church at 1:17 p.m., CST, and after a short meeting with local leaders, talked to a crowd of 350. The talk covered general racial problems in the State of Alabama, and he warned of not being allowed to sleep by the two convictions last week. King noted that there are still many problems concerning racial activity in the South, and that it would be necessary to continue demonstrations and other racial activities. Andrew Young, who is Vice President of the SCLC, accompanied King on his visit to Greenville.

King ended his talk at 2:30 p.m., at which time a march was formed in front of the church, and 350 people paraded in columns of two through the Negro neighborhood until at 2:40 p.m. they were met at the corner of Parmer and South Park Street by City Solicitor Elisha Poole and 40 well armed city and county police. At this time the paraders were led by Reverend Samuel B. Wells, R. B. Cottonreader, and Leon Hall, all of the SCLC, Atlanta. The Negroes sang and protested strongly against not being allowed to march to the county courthouse. Leon Hall was the most vocal of these individuals, and was shocked by an electric baton used by City Solicitor Poole. A Greenville city police officer tapped an unknown marcher in the stomach with his baton. However, there were no other incidents. Andrew Young arrived at the scene at 3:00 p.m., CST,, and turned the marchers around; however, said that there would be marches on a continuing basis until such time as "the Negroes of Greenville are allowed the freedom of the white man." He

further advised that a large mass meeting would be planned for Friday, December 10, 1965, at the Harrison Street Baptist Church.

[REDACTED] advised that as of 5:45 p.m., CST, December 6, 1965, Martin Luther King was still in a church in York (Sumter County), Alabama, and he understood from contacts of his in the Demopolis area, that King was unable to find a church in Demopolis, and as a result, would not be stopping there for any mass meeting.

At 9:15 p.m., CST, December 6, 1965, information was received [REDACTED] that King was leaving York, Alabama, en route Selma, Alabama, with no stops planned in Demopolis or any other place.

It was pointed out to [redacted] that there had been previous publicity that [redacted] have numbered accounts. He was also advised that the Bureau has information that one of the holders of such numbered accounts [redacted] may be MARTIN LUTHER KING, Jr. It was pointed out to [redacted] that the Bureau is not investigating the legitimate activities of KING in the civil rights field but that the Bureau's interest, rather, pertains to communist attempts to influence the civil rights movement.

In response to inquiry, [redacted] specifically stated that he has no information that MARTIN LUTHER KING, Jr., presently has, or, at any time in the past, has had a numbered account [redacted] advised that he had previously [redacted]

[redacted], and can positively state that while he held that position, there were no numbered accounts at that bank. Accordingly, he stated it would not have been possible for KING to have had a numbered account [redacted]

[redacted] did mention that he had heard some comment during the early part of 1965 or in 1964 on the occasion of one of the several visits of MARTIN LUTHER KING, Jr., [redacted] that KING probably was putting money in a numbered account [redacted] explained, however, that he had placed no credence in that comment as he recalls that it was merely a wild conclusion that had been previously drawn by someone whose identity he does not now recall. [REDACTED] b7(D) advised as follows concerning a weekly meeting of the Alabama Christian Movement for Human Rights (ACMHR), held December 13, 1965, at the St. James Baptist Church, 1100 6th Avenue, North, Birmingham, Alabama.

Among those present were John Nixon, NAACP President, C. Ward, Ralph Abernathy, Andrew Young, Hosea Williams of Southern Christian Leadership Conference, and Martin Luther King, Jr.

Dr. King spoke and said that now in seven Alabama counties, Negro voters outnumber white voters. King predicted that Congressmen, sheriffs, and mayors will be elected in the Blackbelt during the next election. He also said that his staff, in cooperation with local organizations, expects to get 80,000 additional Negroes registered during the next sixty days. King challenged the Negroes to march on the Jefferson County Board of Registrars by the thousands, in order for Federal Registrars to come in.

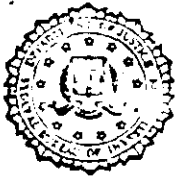
Turning from voter registration, he lambasted city officials for refusing to employ Negro policemen, and declared that it may be necessary to fill the streets again over this issue. King went on to point out that the whole question of justice must quickly be settled in America, saying, "We may have to recommend that Negroes begin sitting in at segregated jury boxes." Re Bureau airtel 11/4/65, setting forth information to the effect that subject had arranged through the Deacons of Defense and Justice, Incorporated, to create a racial disturbance in Chicago "in the next two or three weeks".

This information was immediately disseminated to appropriate local authorities, Secret Service and Army Intelligence in the form as instructed in referenced airtel.

This situation has subsequently been followed closely with appropriate units of the Chicago Police Department, the Human Relations and Intelligence Units, as well as with selected liaison sources and informants. To date there is no indication from any of these sources of information to substantiate the allegations in referenced airtel or that any such racial incident is in the process of being instigated.

These sources advise, regarding the Deacons, that there is no organized unit or chapter in existence in Chicago and ERNEST THOMAS is not known to have been in this area for at least several weeks, possibly longer.

KING has been in Chicago on two instances recently, that is during the period 11/19-20/65 and 11/23-24/65. Letterhead memorandum regarding this travel on his part have set forth his arrival and departure on each occasion and there is no indication, or no information known, that his presence in Chicago had any ulterior motivation or was for the purpose of organizing such an incident as described in referenced airtel.

No letterhead memorandum is being submitted by Chicago in view of the lack of any developments or positive information in this matter. Chicago will continue to be alert to the allegation as set forth and through liaison, which is normally maintained with the sources referred to previously will follow this matter.

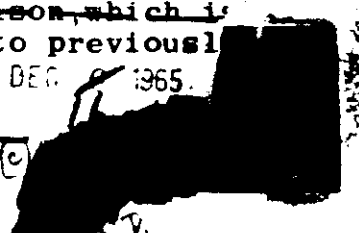
