'A' confidential source, who has furnished reliable information in the past, learned on April 6, 1968, that on that date Stanley Levison's wife stated that there is really no one to take Martin Luther King's place as head of the Southern Christian Leadership Conference (SCLC) but that King more or less named (Ralph) Abernathy as his "heir" She added that this is "not what we would want to see", that Andrew Young (Executive Vice-President of the SCLC) would be preferable but even he would need a lot of help. said Levison, who was in Atlanta, was going to try to turn it over to a governing body, which is the most he can hope for.

The source also ascertained that Stanley Levison later contacted his wife. She inquired about a report that the Field Foundation was going to give the SCLC one million dollars. According to Levison, the Field Foundation contacted the SCLC and said something about two hundred to three hundred to three hundred thousand dollars. He added that it will take a million dollars to keep SCLC going.

Levison commented that there is hostility between Coretta King, Martin Luther King's wife, and "the staff" (SCLC). He said Mrs. King was pushing for a memorial library but the staff was fighting it.

Levison also mentioned that he went to "Daddy King's" house "where most of the meeting took place". He said that the people from Atlanta University came over, "all the people that Daddy King respects -- and they are all National Association for the Advancement of Colored People (NAACP) people." Levison said that the NAACP people from Atlanta University wanted to take over the whole funeral, all the money that will come in,

On April 9, 1968, Special Agents of the FBI observed a mamorial service for Martin Luther King, Jr., held at the bandstand located in Grant Park, Chicago, Illinois. The service was scheduled to begin at 2:00 p.m., but, due to the late arrival of several speakers, the service did not start until approximately 2:30 p.m. People started gathering at the bandstand at 1:30 p.m. At the time the service began there were approximately 400 individuals in the audience, which included about 50 Negroes. There was no indication as to the sponsor of the memorial service; the stated purpose of the service was to honor the memory of Lartin Luther King, Jr.

Included among the speakers were Staughton and and Mike Spiegel, introduced as National Secretary US SES.

Laughton Lynd

The April 18, 1967, edition of the "Chicago Lilly News", a daily Chicago newspaper, described Lynd La Yale University professor and violent protestor against the Viet Nam war.

The article stated that Lynd had taken an unauthorized "peace mission" trip to Hanoi, North Viet Nam, ching 1966 as a result of which he temporarily lost has United States passport.

newspaper, edition of March 27, 1966, contained an article relating to an anti-Viet Nam war affair held early in March, 1966, in Chicago. Lynd was in Chicago to participate in this affair and reportedly stated while here that he had recently applied for membership in the W.E.B. Du Bois Clubs of America.

In August, 1953, Lynd was interviewed by Special Agenus of the Federal Bureau of Investigation. At that time he stated he had never been a Communist Party member, but did state that in the fall of 1946 he had joined the American Youth for Democracy. He had disaffiliated himself from this group in June, 1967. During the interview, Lynd had stated that while at Harvard University in 1947 and 1948, he had been a member of the John Reed Croup, having served as club secretary for approximately one year at this time. The American Youth for Democracy has been designated pursuant to Executive Order 10450.

A characterization of the W.E.B. Du Bois Clubs, Loth local and national, as well as a characterization of the John Reed Club, is attached hereto.

Spiegel stated that Martin Luther King, Jr., was a champion of civil rights and his death would not abstroy the civil rights movement, but, he believed, would give it more impetus.

Staughton Lynd spoke of Martin Luther King, Jr.'s

views concerning the war in Viet Nam. Lynd compared the war in Viet Nam to the liberation of the black community. He called for the immediate withdrawal of troops from Viet Nam and the black community. He also called for the right of self-determination for the Vietnamese people and the black community. Lynd stated that the anti-war slogan should be changed from "Hell no--we won't go" to "Hell no, we won't go to Viet Nam or go into black communities to kill our black brothers".

Other speakers talked of their association with Martin Luther King, Jr., of police brutality tactics utilized by the police and National Guardsmen stationed in the ghetto area during recent rioting in Chicago. Another individual claimed excessive bails had been set for those jailed during the riots and urged the audience to contribute to their aid through the United Legal Bail Bond Appeal, 7932 South Yale Street, Chicago, Illinois.

The Chicago "Sun-Times", a Chicago daily newspaper, in its issue of April 10, 1963, on page 30, contained an article captioned "Thousands Honor King Here". In part, the article stated the rally was sponsored by the Ad Hoc Committee for the Memorial to Doctor Martin Luther King, a group composed of various civil rights and peace groups which included SDS.

A source advised that on October 26-27, 1963, a conference of members of the Communist Party, USA (CPUSA), including national functionaries, met in Chicago, Illinois, for the purpose of setting in motion forces for the establishment of a new national Marxist-oriented youth organization which would have for the most peaceful transition to socialism. The delegates were told that it would be reasonable to assume that the young socialists attracted into this new organization would eventually plas into the CP itself.

A second source has advised that the founding convention for the new youth organization was held from June 19-21, 1964, at most Golden Gate Avenue, San Francisco, California, at which time make W.E.B. DuBois Clubs of America (DCA) was adopted. Approximately 500 delegates from throughout the United States attended this convention.

The second source advised in September, 1966, that MINE MIGHABILL, CPUSA Youth Director, stated that in Negro communities the Party still supported the plan to build "left" socialist centers and to solidify the Party base through the DCA. This course also advised in September, 1966, that DANIEL RUBIN, CPUSA lational Organizational Secretary, stated the Party believes the low should have a working-class outlook and be a mass organization described to socialism, socialist countries and Marxism, and in april, 1967, advised that GUS HALL, CPUSA General Secretary, andicated the DCA primary emphasis should be on developing mass resistance to the draft.





The Associated Press quotes Attorney General Ramsey Clark as saying that FBI Agents are cooperating with the Memphis Police Department and other state and municipal law enforcement organizations in the noble search for some hapless soul on whom vengeance may be wreaked for the Thursday slaying of Nobel Peace laureate Martin Luther King.

Presuming that this one of the few occasions upon which Clark knows what he is talking about, I must ask what legal authority the FBI has to enter a homicide case which has no relevance to national security and did not, as far as anyone knows, entail any violation of the Federal laws of which the Federal Bureau of Investigation is charged with enforcement.

Your record, sir, demands the conclusion that you would have to be overruled before FBI Agents could exceed their legitimate authority and jurisdiction.



However, as I make the following request it may be that such a request is entirely out of reason with the principles of the organization of which you are its able Director.


I have heard that this man has had leanings, been related to various communists front organizations and that such is on record in your files.



The June 28, 1936, issue of "The Worker," an east coast Communist newspaper, reported that Gus Hall had been elected General Secretary of the CP at its 13th National Convention, New York City, June 22-26, 1986.

gave the first report at the conference. Lattis' report consisted of a run-down on the current labor situation and political climate in the United States as viewed by the CP. He stated that in general things were "coming to a head" in the rioting by the Regroes and in the deficit money situation in which the country now found itself. He pointed out that Goorge Heany, President of AFL-CIO, was now in a dilemma as Heany had thrown his support to President Johnson who had announced that he would not run as a candidate for re-election.

Pollowing works' report, the conference continued in the form of discussions by the various delegates. These delegates discussed the labor situations in their respective unions and their particular approaches to the problems encountered.

Carl Winter gave a report on the new Marxist daily newspaper, "The Daily World," following the above discussions. Infer stated that the most modern printing equipment and the latest newspaper techniques and services would be utilized in the publication of this newspaper. Winter noted that half a million dollars had been received in donations by the newspaper whose publication date of May 1, 1988, had been delayed because of some difficulty with the wire services.

The highlight of the second day of the conference was a speech by Gus Hall. Hall spoke concerning the crises in the United States, namely the rioting in the cities, the loss of faith in the dollar and the controversy over the war in Vietnam. He stated that in effect the ruling class had "dumped" President Johnson who had come to the conclusion that he could not win if he ran for re-election.

Hall characterized the CP as a working-class party. Le urged those in attendance at the conference to return to their respective areas and work toward making this a reality. Hall noted that the time was right for CP members to speak out on the issues confronting the nation today.

Hall stated that the CP had already issued a leaflet portaining to the Reverend Dr. Hartin Luber King, Jr., the nationally known civil rights leader who was assassinated at Houphis, Tennessee, on April 4, 1968. Hall stated that about a thousand of these leaflets had been distributed by the CP in the Chicago area. Hall urged delegates to get a supply of these leaflets for distribution in their respective areas.

the principal points stressed at the conference were: 1. Work toward the success of "The Daily World" and 2. Work toward making the CP a working-class Party.

Proposals passed at the conference included sending the late Reverend Dr. Ming a letter of condelence and furnishing the newsmedia the details of proceedings of the conference.

The precreated program for conference was not collowed, as a good proportion of conference pertained to the assaultation of the Reverend Dr. Ling and the racial riots in the chicae across the country following his death. The conference was adjoined early in view of the rioting so that delegates could meaning to their homes without violating curfews then in effect in certain cities.

Dear Mr. Hoover:

I am a housewife and mother of 2 children. I try to keep myself informed on the world situation and the situation here in the U.S. Yesterday I watched the entire funeral of Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. After watching it I came away more confused about the man than prior to the funeral. As I listened to all the speeches about the kind of person he was and what he wanted to do, I began to feel a little sad about what I thought he was. I am still confused.

I never in all the time I heard him speak thought of him as being a peaceloving person. His manner of speaking, the words he spoke, and the feeling he put across to me were not especially non-violent. And now some of the very people who critized him are now praising him as the greatest peacemaker of these times. It was my feeling that he was trying to tear the U.S. apart using the black peoples grievances as his tool. If he was so much for peace, then why did he predict such a negative atmosphere that every summer the U.S. will have riots? I don't understand what he was really trying to do.

If I remember correctly you said something to the effect one time that Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. was the most notorious liar in the country. That has been on my mind also. Could you please explain that statement a Petile? Itals hard to believe that he would have had the nerve to trick and fool his race into destroying their own country, and use the pulpit of Christianity to stand behind. Please give me an answer as to your opinion of him, and what he was really trying to accomplish.

Dear Sir:

During these days of crises, our ditizens are becoming more and more alarmed with lawlessness and civil disobedience.

About three weeks ago Sen. Strom Thurmond urged that the official report from the F.B.I. on Dr. Martin Luther King be made public. I should like to urge you as an official representative from this state to support this move and that the American people be informed about the real Martin Luther King. As a public servant I believe you to be interested in the welfare of this nation.

I should also like to urge you that the report on racial disorders from the F.B.I. be made public. I realize that it is important that certain information be withheld at certain times, but what could be more important than publicly exposing those who are subtly destroying this nation of ours with a false front of non-violence.

I do not recall the woman's organization, or the spokesman for them when you were asked about Dr. King and you said he was the most notorious liar in the country. I'd like to have if possible this program account, or any summary of King'scoming's going's and doing's.

Now I am not a fanatic, but I resent the us flag being lowered to half staff, while communist all over the world were also joining in with Americans in mourning; and memorial service, as a tribute to an alumnus. A confidential source, who has furnished reliable information in the past, learned on March 29, 1968, that on that date, Stanley Levison and Martin Luther King, Jr. discussed the position which King has found himself in as a result of the violence that occurred in Memphis, Tennessee, on March 28, 1968, at the time when King led a march through downtown Memphis. told Levison that he feels they have to face the fact that,

"we from a public relations point of view and every other way, "we are in serious trouble". He referred to the Washington D.C. Spring campaign, known as the Poor People's Campaign, and said ias far as it is concerned it is in trouble. King noted that it will be much more difficult to recruit people for the Washington gampaign now because they (the Southern Christian Leadership Conference)(SCLC) are recruiting non-violent people and these Meople will hold back if they think they will be in a campaign that is going to be taken over by violent elements. King stated that this is not a failure for the SCLC because it has enough a program to affirm its position but that it is a personal Betback for himself.

King continued that persons such as Roy Wilkens Head of the National Association for the Advancement of Colored People) and Adam Clayton Powell, and Negroes who are influenced by the press, will now feel that he, King, is finished, that his non-violence is nothing, that no one is listening to it. King reiterated that they have had a great public relations setback as far as his image and leadership are concerned./y

Levison attempted to dissuade King from this point of view stating that it would be true only if King accepts "their" definition. He added that he felt it is a profound error King is making.

King noted that he did not accept it himself but that others will. Levison retorted that people would accept it for a few days, but, if events prove otherwise, will not accept it.

King noted that events will not prove otherwise unless they think soberly through this period. He said that somehow he had to reaffirm what the press will refuse to affirm. He referred to the Memphis incident stating that they all know it was just a few people who were involved. He added that it was a failure of the leadership in Memphis. King informed Levison that persons who were responsible for the violence came to see him on the morning of March 29, 1968. He said these persons were fighting the leadership in Memphis, the men who ignored and neglected them, the men who would not give them any attention, who ordered their telephones cut off. King added that he had no knowledge of all this, that the persons responsible for the violence were too sick to see that what they were doing during the violence was hurting him, King, more than it could hurt the local preachers.

King related that he was so upset and shocked over the Memphis violence that he was going to announce a personal fast as a means of appealing to the Memphis leadership, as well as those who participated in the violence, to come to him in a united front to take up the "cudget" and get on with the movement. He said he felt this kind of spiritual move would be a way of unifying the movement, of transforming a minus into a plus. He added that he feels their Washington campaign is doomed.

Levison attempted to convince King that his reasoning was not correct. Levison said he was concerned over the "trap" King was placing non-violence in because King was saying that he must have 100% adherence to non-violence which is an impossibility

King commented that they could not get 100% adherence but that they must face the fact that ariot broke out in the ranks of the march, that "these fellows", in the line of march, would (c)

jump out, do something, and then come back to hide within the group. King said he is a symbol of non-violence and that the press is not going to say what Levison said. He said the symbol will be weakened and it will put many Negroes in doubt. He said he must do something that is a powerful act to unify forces and refute the press.

Levison stated that if it had this result he would agree but that he is bothered by the idea that King would be accepting the logic of the press that if King can control 99%, and not the 1% who are violent, he is a failure. He said they must find a way in which they do not accept this otherwise King will never be able to do anything unless he always spiritually reaches a level where he hypnotizes every Negro alive.

King questioned how he could say that they can control the planned demonstrations in Washington, D.C. and at the same time conclude they are going to have 1% violence.

Levison counseled that King can say that he can control his followers and is not undertaking to control everybody else. He said King could take the position that his followers are non-violent and will do what they must do.

They agreed to discuss the matter in depth at a meeting in Atlanta, Georgia in King's church office on the morning of March 30, 1968.

The same source advised on March 31, 1968, that on that date Stanley Levison commented on the meeting held in Atlanta, Georgia, on March 30, 1968. Levison's comments included the following:

At the Atlanta meeting they examined the whole Memphis incident and came up with a new approach. "We are going back to Memphis. We are going to prove that you can have mass action in the streets". Martin Luther King had decided not to go back to Memphis and not to go to Washington (for the Poor People's Campaign). It was the determination of the (SCLC) staff that







changed King's thinking. King is going back to Memphis on Tuesday (April 2, 1968) and there will be a big march on Friday (April 5, 1968). The Memphis incident was caused by "a handful of kids" and it could have been controlled by "our guys" (the SCLC) had they been there.

He, Levison, made the point that they could not let "a couple of kids" keep "mass action" from being their weapon.

As for controlling the Washington, D.C. demonstrations, King knows he can control the youth. What has to be done is go to the high schools and tell them what the establishment wants them to do. Once they grasp this there is no chance of anything happening. What they (the SCLC) are afraid of in Washington is a double cross from Stokley Carmichael and the answer to that is that "our job" (the SCLC") is not to stop violence but to be non-violent themselves. "Our position" is that "we" are going to go on because to be able to march inthe streets is "our most important tool" and are not going on the streets because it may start violence. "Why do we have to be afraid of riots. It is their problem not ours".

The Atlanta meeting was good because it shows how much militancy there is in the SCLC.
