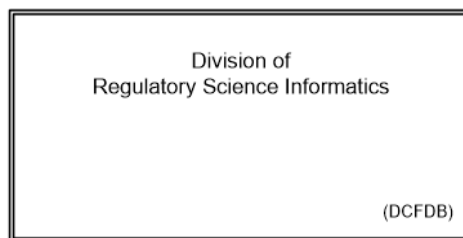
**1. Division of Regulatory Science Informatic (DCFDB).**

- A. Coordinates information management activities and ensures the completeness, accuracy, and integrity of data.
- B. Develops data and electronic submission standards to maximize efficiency and consistency.
- C. Develops requirements for data management systems to support the full range of regulatory science projects, including preparation of reports for management use.
