

From Mombasa to Aden  
the only birds noted  
were a few hooded Gulls  
as Aden was approached

One Ring-bird, 1 Yellow  
Wingtail, and a pair of  
Hoopoes were with us one  
day from Aden.

On the day we arrived  
at Port Sudan, a lot of  
Swallows (Hirundo)  
one Wingtail and one Ring-  
bird were on the ship; and  
Hooded Gulls followed it  
from Aden to Port Sudan.

At Port Suez were many  
Black-backed Gulls (Black  
mantle, white head, tail, belly  
& lining of wings & white  
tips to ~~primary~~ secondary  
wing-quills. These Gulls were  
abundant through the Canal  
& followed the ship from Port Said until
