The holes in the back were made at the instigation of Bonelli in order to give it the appearance of an antique gem.

14 An tmportant Englisif 16th Century Cameo consisting of a crescentshaped panel minutely carved with portraits of Henry VIII, Queen Elizabeth, Queen Mary and Edward VI, the cameo decorated at either side with the head of a winged cupid, in gold setting of later date
** From the Harmon Oates Collection, sold in these Rooms November 9th, 1929, lot 144.

** This cameo was found in the Tiber in Rome in 1886.
