





Early Morning Star The color is a deep orange scarlet or flame color in standard with rich orange pink wings. The flower is practically the same color as the late flowering Spencer "Dobbie's Thomas Stevenson." It does not burn badly out in the open and under glass will be magnificent. The flowers are large and of best Spencer form and borne in threes and fours in wonderful profusion. Under artificial light it is superb.
