"Freezer lockers" for storing meats and other foods for individual households are growing in popularity in Cold-storage and ice companies have put in many of these freezer lockers, which both town and country residents rent for from \$7 to \$10 a year. Pacific Northwest States have been using them about 5 years, and within the past 2 or 3 years other sections have also become interested.

In addition to meats, poultry, game, fruits, vegetables, and butter are the principal products frozen. Some farm families use lockers to such an extent that home canning is practically eliminated as a means of preserving meats and nonacid vegetables like beans and peas which require special equipment for safe canning.

The neighborhood freezer-locker has many advantages for the farmer who has home-dressed meat. The variety of meat cuts on the table is greatly increased and distributed over a much longer time than when the principal meat supply has to be either canned or cured.

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
