THIS Genealogy is the one referred to in the letter on the opposite page, given to my grandfather, Richard Frothingham, January 1, 1851. The diagrams, accounts of the family, etc., are photographic reproductions from the original manuscript book now in my possession. There have been no additions to the text. Three additional pages have been bound into the book, preceding the account of William Frothingham. (Page 33). Two are reproductions of additional data taken by Mr. Wyman from British and Scottish Records. On the third page is an extract from Mr. Wyman's later book. It seems proper to include these pages, as they give more definite information concerning our first American ancestor.

## Frothingham

This name bears a similitude to Fotheringham a surname extant in Scotland at a remote period. Frodingham is the name of a town in Lincolnshire, and Frodlingham appears on a map as a town in Yorkshire, England.

Frodingham is written as the surname of the earliest individuals of this family on the ancient records in New-England. The same persons identically, continue to be recorded by the name of Frothingham which is the commonly received version of the family name at the present day.

Where the surname of a family is the same as that of a Place, it is understood by the best authorities that the family name is subordinate, derived from the place. "Lowers's English Surnames" page 37. says "there is scarcely a city, town, village, manor, hamlet or estate in England that has not lent its name to swell the nomenclature of Englishmen".

"In ford, ham, ley and ton, — The most of English surnames run".

The same author enlarges upon the definition of names and roots of names. On page 46, he defines "Froith - a plain among woods. In Scotland, an arm of the sea. On page 48, "Ang - a meadow or low ground. On 47th page, "Ham - a dwelling, whence home. often applied in the southern counties to a triangular field or croft.

## Arms.

The armorial bearings of a family are important to be considered in view of its earliest origin and history. The heraldic devices denote the descent and alliance that may be attributed to the bearer of arms.

"Burkes Armory" and "Edmondson's Heraldry" describe the following. - "Froddingham (Gloldernup) [Yorkshire.] Az. a bend between six mullets or." - "Frodingham [Yorkshire] Az. a bend ar. between six mullets or." - "Frothingham (South Frothingham Co in Yorkshire) Az. a bend ar. between six mullets or." - Crest, a stag tripping proper attired gu. - In the above works these symbols are all minutely explained.

A brief interpretation of the description of Arms may be here given. Az. - azure, signifies blue; the appropriate color of the shield on which these Arms are drawn. A bend may be termed a 'wide, straight bar' (not a curve as some might imply) crossing the shield from dexter-chief (the right hand side of the bearer,) downward diagonally to the sinister-base (the left hand side of the bearer but as the print or painting of the Arms is viewed, the dexter-chief of course appears at the left hand of the observer, and the sinister base at the right; this it is well to have understood in the description.) Ar. - argent, signifies silver; paper on which the drawing is made, being devoid of coloring in the argent space is a proper representation. The bend on this shield, therefore, may be of silver lustre, or uncolored. The six mullets (a mullet is the rowel of a spur) resemble stars, but of five points only, and are of golden lustre which is the interpretation of or. The shield being equally divided by the bend crossing diagonally, three mullets are placed in each division, upper and lower.

The symbol called a Mullet indicates "the third son".

The Crest surmounting the Shield is a Stag in a tripping or trotting attitude of motion; - proper that may be understood to mean its natural color (which may be some hue that is not used in heraldry; Brown for instance has no heraldic term. The animal may be spotted if it suits the taste of the designer. Attired applies to the appendages of the animal or figure; it signifies in this instance the horns or antlers of the stag, which are of red color the signification of gu-gules.

The Scroll beneath is for the inscription of the motto. None is ascertained as belonging to these Arms.

A very neatly executed painting of the Arms of Frothingham, done by Miss Sarah K. Frothingham, about forty years ago, and taken from a design which was nearly correct, is now in possession of a branch of the family in Charlestown. It is said that a person traversed the vicinity of Boston, 40 or 50 years ago, and painted coats of Arms for many people. Those who are well versed in heraldry, do not give his paintings a very high reputation for accuracy.

## History

According to Nisbett, (Book of Heraldry, Edinburgh, 1722) the first of the name of Fotheringham of Powrie came from Hungary with Margaret the bride of Malcolm (Banmore) III. King of Scotland [abt 1057.] This family obtained the lands of Wester-Powrie by an alliance with a daughter of Ogilvy of Auchterhouse about 1399; whence descended the Saird of Powrie.

Fotheringham of Sawhill second son of the family of Purie or Powrie.

Fotheringham of Bindon younger son of Purie or Powrie.

Powrie was the property and long the residence of this ancient family. Antiquities &c of the place are three old castles, which however present no remarkable peculiarities in structure or location; the memorials of the feudal times.

"Rymers Fœdera", a Record of Parliament &c. Vol 6. p 66 mentions Johannes [John] de Foderyngham "Familiaris Comit'is de Sutherland" 1357.

"Rymer" vol 10. p 338 has John Fotheringham, among Scottish names, 1424.

The "Journal of the House of Lords" Vol 22 p 45, has the Record of a Suit "David Fotheringham vs Espinola" Dec 6th. 9th of George I. a Writ of Error. judgement in 1722.

In the "Calendar" superadded to Records of the House of Lords, 4th of February 9th of George 2 [1735.] Thomas Fotheringham Esq. of Fowrie petitions in behalf of Agnes Turnbull, Thomas Alexander and George Fotheringham her children. This case is very briefly noted, and not entirely intelligible.

The same work mentions, November 23. 1768. Thomas Fotheringham Esq. of Forfar, in answer to John Scott, writer, of Edinburgh.

The same work mentions. Case July 10. 1797. Fotheringham vs Ogilvie. This was an appeal from the Court of Interlocutors in Scotland to the House of Lords. To wit: William Fotheringham only son [minor] of Dr Norman Fotheringham,



deceased, Arch-Deacon of Coventry; the second son  
 Thomas Fotheringham Ogilvie Esq. of Towrie, de-  
 ceased, and Elizabeth his wife. versus Col Alex.  
Balcarras Fotheringham Ogilvie of Towrie, Mary  
 Kerr, his wife and their children Thomas -  
 James - Peter - Alexander - Frederick - Anne  
 and Mary Fotheringham.

The preceding author-  
 ities are printed volumes. The information con-  
 veyed therein is very brief. The "Records of the House  
 of Lords" are in the library of Mass. State House.

Later knowledge of the existence of the family in  
 Scotland is derived from the "New Statistical Acc't  
 of Scotland by the ministers of the Parishes".

It mentions (Vol. 9. p 591-2. Edinburgh 1745.) —

Thomas-Fredrick Scrymgeour Fotheringham, a  
 minor, a land owner in the parish of Murroes  
 or Muirhouse, five miles from Dundee in the shire  
 of Angus or Forfar.

More extensive examination of  
 European authorities, (if the compiler had opportunity,)  
 would render the historical portion more complete.

Inscribed in the following pages will be found all persons who have become known to the compiler as bearing the name Trothingham or its similitudes anywhere. There will be found recapitulated in alphabetical order, the names of those previously mentioned, also some who have appeared in the country of late years; apparently, by name, of all the same family.

Their chain of connection is now wanting to the purpose; but although invisible to present observation, there is not the less probability that the genealogic process from generation to generation, has been developed as well for the separated and scattered portions of the family as for the more compactly located New-England branch, the data of which has been so easily accessible for the material of this work.

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## Authorities

The authorities which are recognized as the sources of New-England family history and genealogy, and which have been consulted by the compiler are as follows;

Town Records of Marriages, Births, Deaths &c.

Church Records of Marriages, Baptisms, Deaths &c.

Probate Records of Wills, Inventories, Distributions &c.

Deed Registries of Conveyances & (explaining family connection.)

Private Diaries - Records of Funerals, weddings, births &c.

County Records - Returns of Town Records Court proceedings &c.

Published Genealogies - (to some small extent.)

Oral Tradition - (to a very limited extent)

Grave Yards - as corroborating records, or supplying the absolute want thereof in very many cases.

The "Massachusetts Archives", (in the State House) and The "United States published Documents" - afford some aid.

Manuscript Letters, occasionally more minute and reliable than oral information: several have aided this work.

## Arrangement.

The inductive method of preparing Genealogies is in "progressive order" (after the material is obtained) arranging generation after generation in the order of precedence.

In an arrangement of Genealogy for reference, the inductive plan may well be dispensed with; for it claims too much of the examiner to require that he should go through the books to the end to find the name he seeks.

This collection is therefore arranged in Alphabetical Order, after a few Diagrams are given which will be interesting and need no explanation beyond what the succeeding pages furnish.

### FROTHINGHAM

William I. From Yorkshire, England; Holderness was the family locality; anterior to or coeval with his emigration, the name was in Scotland; came in Winthrop's fleet; inhabitant, 1630; freeman of the colony, 1632; with wife, member of church, 1632; an adherent of Rev. John Wheelwright (bro. of Mrs. Hutchinson), 1637, but renounced adhesion . . . .

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The above extract is from Mr. Wyman's later book, and the two preceding pages are extracts from British and Scottish Records, compiled by Mr. Wyman, in his own hand, and given to Richard Frothingham to be kept with the Genealogy.

It should be noted that, at the foot of the second page of the Records, Mr. Wyman underlined a word to emphasize his belief that he had identified the Immigrant, which is very significant from such a careful man.

It is also significant that in the later book, "The Genealogies and Estates of Charlestown," Mr. Wyman definitely states that William Frothingham came from Yorkshire, and that he came to New England in Winthrop's fleet. These statements show that Mr. Wyman's later researches convinced him that such were the facts.

William Frothingham or Frothingham of Charlestown,  
was an Inhabitant in the year 1630.

No light has been discovered to reveal the place in England or Scotland whence he came, the Ship which conveyed him to this port, or the exact period of his arrival here. Recent discoveries have exhibited evidence on these important points concerning some of the other settlers. Hon. James Savage has published in "Historical Collections" his "Gleanings" from ancient Records in England which exhibit the names, ages and occupations of many of the first settlers, the dates of shipment, and the names of the vessels which bro't them to this country. It is expected that continued research may develop these very important particulars concerning this and many other early families.

Our Ancestor may be supposed to have shared in the usual efforts incident to finding a subsistence and maintaining safety for himself and family amidst the perils and constraints of a wild settlement; and at the same time to have been interested in perpetuating a civil community on the highest known principles of truth and religion. William Frothingham and his wife Ann were original members of the Church in Charlestown at its first gathering. They signed the Covenant with 33 others Nov 2, 1632!

No occupation has been attributed to him by record. It therefore appears probable that he was a Cultivator of the Soil, then the most customary, and (as at this day) the most happy employment. There were a few mechanics manufacturers and tradesmen in those days, and quite a few managers or gentlemen of ease.

The following extract from the Book of Possessions - Town Record Vol. 2, leaf 17. is verbatim. It is a good description of the boundary and extent of his Farm. "The possession of William Frothingale in Charltowne - four acres of arable land by estimation more or less situate in the east filde butting southwest upon the streete way north upon mistick river bounded on the west by Ed Mellows & Abr Pratt & on the east by George Bunker & Tho Parker w<sup>th</sup> a dwelling house upon it 2 Two Acres of meadow by estimation more or less situate in the high filde meade butting south upon Ralph Sprague James Tompson & John Nussell to the north upon Northrop necke bounded on the east by John Nussell & on the west by Will Batchelor 3 Two acres of arable land by estimation more or less situate in the Line filde butting south west upon Cambridge Line north east upon the comon bounded on the southeast by Rice Cole & on the north west by Mr. Hill 4 Cow comons three and a half - and a quarter more - bought of Walter Pamer one comon and 3 quarters - of Thomas

Grover one comon; in all 6 comons and a halfe.

Mr Graves Sott." The Date of the preceding Document is 1637. On leaf or page 137 Vol 2 of the Town Record is the Deed of Purchase made by Ann Frothingham (wid: of Grace Palmer. viz: "Dwelling House, Orchard and 5 Acres of Pasture and the cow common in the stinted pasture" this property was near to that before described. Date 1656.

William Frothingham executed his Will, but no record is in the Probate Office. A copy is possessed by the family at Portland. Ann Frothingham's Will is in the Office. By the latter instrument chiefly, the property since enjoyed by their descendants is first conveyed by bequest and has been transmitted faithfully from generation to generation.

This Posterity must indeed be devoid of Gratitude, to be unmindful of, or wish to treat with levity and neglect the record and remembrance of their Pilgrim Ancestor. It is commended to all who peruse the following pages to consider with reverence the memory of those now passed beyond the vale of life. And that no living person may cavil at mention made of them in the collection, it must be understood that the work is of a Statistical nature, and formed almost entirely of matter of public record for any one to examine and use.

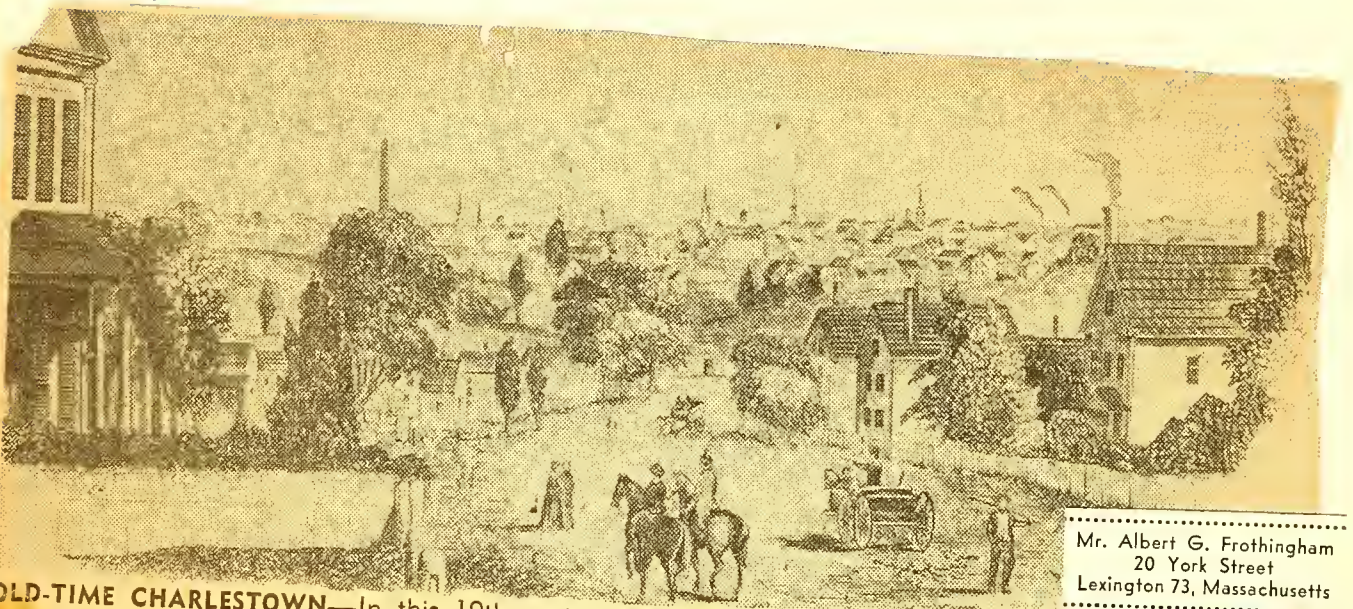

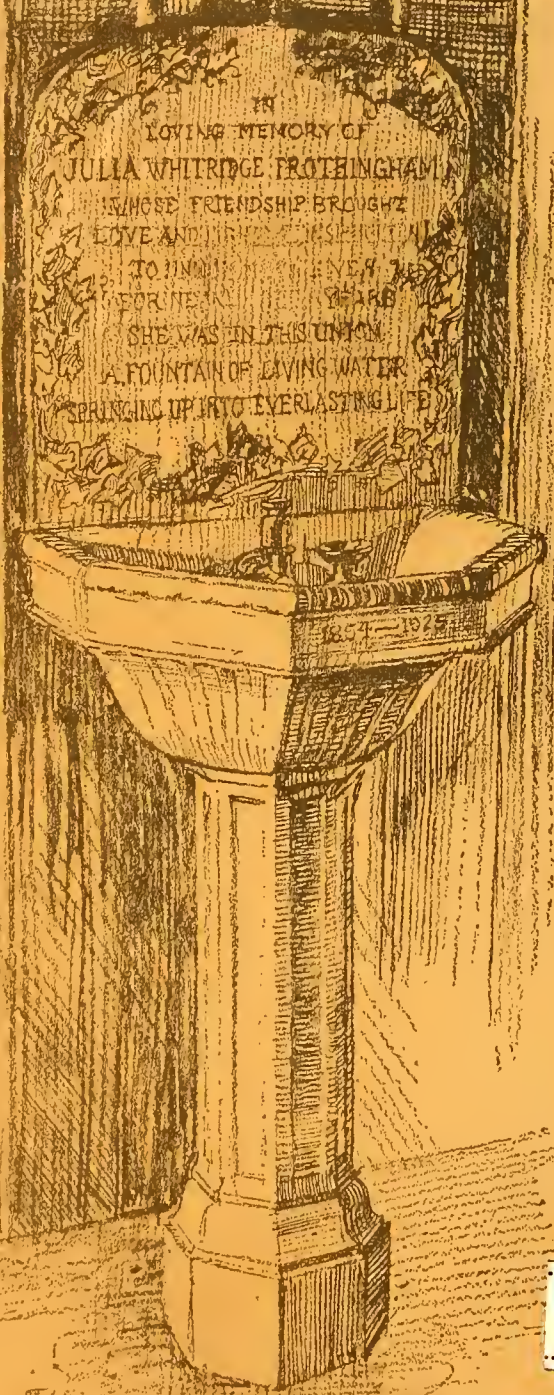
