## Main documentation

- **What's new in Cubase VST 5.1?**

If you have used earlier versions of Cubase VST, this document helps you find information about the most important new features in version 5.1.

- **Getting into the Details.**

This is the main manual, with descriptions of most of the features in Cubase VST.

- **Score Printing and Layout.**

If you use Cubase VST Score or Cubase VST/32, you have access to advanced scoring facilities, described in this document.

- **Troubleshooting.**

This helps you sort out a number of common problems.

## VST Device Reference

- **VST Instruments.**

This document contains descriptions of the included VST Instruments.

- **VST Effect Plugins.**

This document contains descriptions of the included Audio Effects.

- **Earlier VST Plugins.**

With Cubase VST 5.0, a completely new set of VST plug-ins was introduced. However, all the pre-5.0 standard plug-ins are also included, to facilitate playback of Songs made with earlier Cubase versions. This document describes the earlier VST effect plug-ins.

- **VST Remote Control Devices.**

It is possible to control the VST mixers from an external MIDI device. This document describes the supported Remote Control Devices.

## Additional documentation

- **Using Cubase VST with RocketPower.**

Describes how to use the RocketPower feature, which allows you to collaborate with other Cubase users over the Internet.

- **Modules.**

Cubase VST comes with a number of Modules with various functionality. This document describes how to work with Modules and also contains details about the included Modules.

- **System Exclusive Handling.**

Describes how to work with MIDI System Exclusive messages in the SysEx Editor module.

- **The MIDI Mixer and Mix Tracks.**

This document describes how to work with the MIDI Mixer, a window which allows you to control practically any aspect of your connected MIDI devices, from within Cubase VST.

- **The Interactive Phrase Synthesizer.**

This document describes the Interactive Phrase Synthesizer, a feature in Cubase VST that helps you create new music by transforming and synthesizing musical phrases.

- **Tape Tracks - Controlling Tape Recorders.**

Describes how to use Cubase VST to control tape recorders and similar devices.

- **ASIO MME Testing.**

Describes how to test your audio hardware when using the ASIO Multimedia driver.

- **Using Cubase VST/32 with DSP Factory.**

Describes how to use Cubase VST with the Yamaha DSP Factory card (Cubase VST/32 only!).
