TOOLS for CC121 Installation Guide

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What is TOOLS for CC121?

TOOLS for CC121 consists of two software components: USB-MIDI Driver and Steinberg CC121 Extension. In particular, you should install the USB-MIDI Driver to enable proper communication between the CC121 and your computer. You should also install Steinberg CC121 Extension to ensure optimum control over Cubase. The TOOLS for CC121 Installer installs these two software components.

NOTE

System Requirements for Software

The system requirements below are necessary for installing TOOLS for CC121.

NOTE

- Note that the system requirements may be slightly different from those described below depending on the particular operating system.

Using the software with Cubase 5 series

■ Windows

OS	Windows XP Professional (SP3 or later) / XP Home Edition (SP3 or later) / Vista (SP1 or later) / 7
CPU	Pentium / Athlon 2GHz or higher (dual core CPU recommended)
Memory	1GB or more (2GB or more on Windows 7 64-bit)
Display Resolution	1280 × 800 — full color
Interface	Equipped with a USB connector
Hard Disk	Free disk space of 100MB or more; high-speed hard disk

■ Macintosh

OS	Mac OS X 10.5.x / Mac OS X 10.6.x
CPU	PowerPC G5 (Intel Core Duo CPU recommended)
Memory	1GB or more
Display Resolution	1280 × 800 — full color
Interface	Equipped with a USB connector
Hard Disk	Free disk space of 50MB or more; high-speed hard disk

Using the software with Cubase 4 series

■ Windows

OS	Windows XP Professional (SP3 or later) / XP Home Edition (SP3 or later) / Vista (SP1 or later, 32-bit)
CPU	Pentium / Athlon 1.4GHz or higher
Memory	512MB or more
Display Resolution	1280 × 800 — full color
Interface	Equipped with a USB connector
Hard Disk	Free disk space of 100MB or more; high-speed hard disk

■ Macintosh

OS	Mac OS X 10.4.11 / Mac OS X 10.5.x
CPU	PowerPC G4 1GHz or higher, or Core Solo 1.5GHz or higher
Memory	512MB or more
Display Resolution	1280 × 800 — full color
Interface	Equipped with a USB connector
Hard Disk	Free disk space of 50MB or more; high-speed hard disk

Software Installation

Follow the steps below to install the software.

NOTE

- If the same software components have already been installed in your computer, you can use the same procedure as described in the Installation instructions here to update the software.

■ Windows XP

Preparing to install

- 1** Make sure that the [STANDBY/ON] switch of the CC121 is in the STANDBY (■) position.
- 2** Disconnect all the devices other than the mouse and keyboard from the computer, then connect the CC121 directly to the computer (without using a hub) by using a USB cable.
- 3** Start the computer and log on to the Administrator account.
Exit any open applications and close all open windows.
- 4** Select [Start] (→ [Settings]) → [Control Panel], click “Switch to Classic View” in the upper left of the window.
- 5** Go to [System] → [Hardware] → [Driver Signing] → [Driver Signing Options], and select the radio button to the left of “Ignore - Install the software anyway and don’t ask for my approval” and click [OK].

NOTE

- After completing the installation, make sure to restore the original settings if necessary.

- 6** Close the System Properties window by clicking the [OK] button or the Close button ([X]) to close the Control Panel.

Software Installation

The installer will install the following two software components to your computer.

- USB-MIDI Driver
- Steinberg CC121 Extension

NOTE

- Use the Cancel button or Close button to quit the installation. Quitting by using the [Ctrl]+[Alt]+[Delete] buttons or by turning off the power while installation is in process can result in problems since the installation is terminated without performing a proper uninstall.

- 7** Double-click “setup.exe” in the compressed file (you have downloaded).

A “Welcome to the InstallShield Wizard for TOOLS for CC121” window appears.

- 8** Click [Next].
- 9** Follow the on-screen instructions in the Setup window for USB-MIDI Driver and Steinberg CC121 Extension appearing in order.

NOTE

- If a message “The software you are installing has not passed Windows Logo Testing” appears, click [Continue Anyway]. You do not need to abort the installation. If the message does not appear, proceed to the next step.

- 10** When installation is complete, a message indicating so appears. If restarting of the computer is necessary following successful completion of the installation, make sure that the radio button to the left of “Yes, I want to restart my computer now” is selected, then click [Finish] to restart the computer. If restarting the computer is unnecessary, click [Finish] to exit the installation process.

- 11** Press the [STANDBY/ON] switch of the CC121 to set it to the ON position.

The “Found New Hardware Wizard” window appears.

NOTE

- Some computers may take a while to display the Wizard window.
- A dialog box may appear asking you whether you wish to connect to Windows Update. In this case, select the radio button to the left of “Not at this time,” then click [Next].

12 Select the radio button next to “Install the software automatically” then click [Next].

This operation starts the USB-MIDI driver’s installation.

NOTE 

- If a message “The software you are installing has not passed Windows Logo Testing” appears, click [Continue Anyway]. You do not need to abort the installation. If the message does not appear, proceed to the next step.


13 When a message indicating installation is complete appears, click [Finish].

14 When a window appears requiring you to restart your computer appears, follow the on-screen instructions to restart the computer.

This completes installation of the necessary software.

■ Windows Vista / Windows 7

Preparing to install

- 1** Make sure that the [STANDBY/ON] switch of the CC121 is in the STANDBY () position.
- 2** Disconnect all the devices other than the mouse and keyboard from the computer, then connect the CC121 directly to the computer (without using a hub) by using a USB cable.
- 3** Start the computer and log on to the Administrator account.

Exit any open applications and close all open windows.

Software Installation

The installer will install the following two software components to your computer.

- USB-MIDI Driver
- Steinberg CC121 Extension

NOTE 

- Use the Cancel button or Close button to quit the installation. Quitting by using the [Ctrl]+[Alt]+[Delete] buttons or by turning off the power while installation is in process can result in problems since the installation is terminated without performing a proper uninstall.

4 Double-click “setup.exe” in the compressed file (you have downloaded).

A “Welcome to the InstallShield Wizard for TOOLS for CC121” window appears.

NOTE 

- If the “User Account Control” window appears, click [Continue].

5 Click [Next].

6 Follow the on-screen instructions in the Setup window for USB-MIDI Driver and Steinberg CC121 Extension appearing in order.

NOTE 

- If the “Windows Security” window appears, confirm that the publisher is “YAMAHA CORPORATION,” then click [Install].

7 When installation is complete, a message indicating so appears. If restarting of the computer is necessary following successful completion of the installation, make sure that the radio button to the left of “Yes, I want to restart my computer now” is selected, then click [Finish] to restart the computer. If restarting the computer is unnecessary, click [Finish] to exit the installation process.


8 Press the [STANDBY/ON] switch of the CC121 to set it to the ON position.

The USB-MIDI Driver is installed automatically.

This completes installation of the necessary software.

■ Macintosh

Preparing to install

- 1 Make sure that the [STANDBY/ON] switch of the CC121 is in the STANDBY () position.
- 2 Disconnect all the devices other than the mouse and keyboard from the computer, then connect the CC121 directly to the computer (without using a hub) by using a USB cable.
- 3 Start the computer and log on to the Administrator account.
Exit any open applications and close all open windows.

- 5 Click [Continue].
- 6 Execute the installation by following the onscreen directions.

NOTE

- Only the boot disk can be selected for the installer.

- 7 When a message appears indicating that the installation is complete, click [Close].

Software Installation

- 4 Double-click “TOOLS for CC121.mpkg” in the compressed file (you have downloaded).
A “Welcome to the InstallShield Wizard for TOOLS for CC121” window appears.

NOTE

- If a dialog box appears asking if you want to install the software, click [Continue].

This completes installation of the necessary software.

Uninstalling the Software

Follow the steps below to uninstall the software.

■ Windows XP

To uninstall TOOLS for CC121, you must remove the following two software components:

- USB-MIDI Driver
- Steinberg CC121 Extension

- 1 Disconnect all other USB devices except mouse and keyboard from the computer.
- 2 Log on to the Administrator account.
Exit any open applications and close all open windows.

- 3 From the Start menu, select ([Settings] →) [Control Panel] → [Add or Remove Programs] to display the Add or Remove Programs panel.
- 4 Click “Change or Remove Programs” located in the upper left, then select “Yamaha USB-MIDI Driver”/“Steinberg CC121 Extension” from the list in the right panel.
- 5 To uninstall the software, click [Change/Remove] / [Remove].

A dialog box appears. Follow the on-screen instructions to remove the software.

■ Windows Vista / Windows 7

To uninstall TOOLS for CC121, you must remove the following two software components:

- USB-MIDI Driver
- Steinberg CC121 Extension

1 Disconnect all other USB devices except mouse and keyboard from the computer.

2 Log on to the Administrator account.

Exit any open applications and close all open windows.

3 From the Start menu, select [Control Panel] → [Uninstall a program] to call up the “Uninstall or change a program” panel.

4 Select the “Yamaha USB-MIDI Driver”/“Steinberg CC121 Extension.”

5 Click the [Uninstall] / [Uninstall / Change].

Follow the on-screen instructions to remove the software.

NOTE

- If the “User Account Control” window appears, click [Continue].

■ Macintosh

To uninstall TOOLS for CC121, you must remove the following two software components:

- USB-MIDI Driver
- Steinberg CC121 Extension

Removing USB-MIDI driver

To uninstall the driver, delete the following files.

- Each user folder in “Users” → “Library” → “Preferences” → “jp.co.yamaha.USBMIDIDriver.plist” (Created after the Driver has been installed).
- “Library” → “Audio” → “MIDI Drivers” → “YAMAHA USBMIDIDriver.plugin.”
- “Library” → “PreferencePanels” → “YAMAHAUSB MIDIPatch.prefPane.”
- “Library” → “Receipts” → “YAMAHA-USBMIDI Driver.pkg.”
- “Library” → “Receipts” → “YAMAHA-USBMIDI Patch.pkg.”

NOTE

- Only the administrator can delete the driver. Normal users do not have the authority to delete.

Removing Steinberg CC121 Extension

Select [Library] → [Application Support] → [Steinberg] → [Components], then delete the files named “cc121_extension.bundle” and “cc121_extension_u.bundle.”
