An act relating to the California State University, and making an appropriation therefor.

LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

SB 576, as introduced, McPherson. California State University: Monterey County Campus.

Existing law establishes the California State University, and authorizes the operation of its various campuses, including the Monterey County campus, under the administration of the Trustees of the California State University.

This bill would appropriate, without regard to fiscal year, \$140,000 from the General Fund to the Chancellor of the California State University. The sum would be for allocation to the President of California State University, Monterey County, for the purpose of preparing, as specified, a long-term, multi-use strategic regional plan for the Monterey Bay region.

Vote: $\frac{2}{3}$. Appropriation: yes. Fiscal committee: yes. State-mandated local program: no.

The people of the State of California do enact as follows:

1 SECTION 1. (a) The sum of one hundred forty
2 thousand dollars (\$140,000) is hereby appropriated,
3 without regard to fiscal year, from the General Fund to
4 the Chancellor of the California State University.

1 (b) The sum appropriated by this section is for
2 allocation to the President of California State University,
3 Monterey County, for the purpose of preparing a
4 long-term, multi-use strategic regional plan that
5 identifies ways in which collaborations among the public,
6 private, and federal higher education and research assets
7 in the greater Monterey Bay area can meet critical needs
8 in the business, education, government, and military
9 domains. In addition to fully documenting the wide range
10 of regional strengths and capacities, this plan shall
11 provide a model “roadmap” by which any local
12 organization, or outside organization, will be able to
13 collaborate with the academic or research and
14 development institutions of the region in order to more
15 effectively integrate into, and add value to, the regional
16 economy.

17 (c) Upon completion, copies of this plan shall be
18 submitted to the chairs of the committees on local
19 government of the Senate and the Assembly, to the
20 Executive Director of the Coastal Commission, and to the
21 chairs of the boards of supervisors of the counties of
22 Monterey, Santa Clara, and Santa Cruz.
