Early History of the Meyer Family

The information I have below has been given to me by one of the children of August Meyer, Elizabeth Meyer Ross, who remembers this as having been told to her by her father.

First I asked her to help me with the order of birth of the five children of Dorothea and Diedrich Meyer. As she remembers having seen them all at some time in their lives she believes this to be the correct order of their birth. I did not see the tombstones to help me.

Elizabeth Ross believes that August Meyer was the first of the family to come to the United States, although she has no record of the year, possibly it might be around 1860. She has no record of how the others came, when they came, or why they came.

August Meyer told her that he decided to leave Germany (no record of town or area) because of the draft law which meant he would have to join the German army. Because he didn't have the passage money, he stowed away on a freighter until it was too far from shore to return. He then came out and was used as a cabin boy for the remainder of the trip to pay his way.

Upon arrival at New York, he had to pawn his watch to get money for food. This lasted for a few days.

Some time later he came to Carroll County, Iowa where he bought approximately 120 acres of land for \$1 or \$2 an acre. He definitely was one of the early pioneers of Western Iowa. Prairie spread in all directions from his homestead.

He met his first wife, Marie Woolenburg near Chicago, Illinois and they returned to Iowa. She died soon after the birth of their fourth child and was buried at Beecher, Illinois. August Meyer then married Catherine Kettleon of near Templeton who gave birth to three additional children.

Elizabeth Ross remembers August talking about going out on the prairie and pulling redroot for fuel. They had to haul wheat to Carroll to grind into flour.

The following is the verse that is to be found on the tombstone of Dorothea and Diedrich Meyer.

2. The original five children are not placed in the book by their correct order of birth.
3. I have strived to place the birth of children under each set of parents in their correct order of birth.
4. Each generation has been placed below their parents and to the right.
5. _____ This means that I did not have the information at the time of publication.
6. Generally speaking, I do not have the address given of the spouse of a direct descendant who has passed on.
7. A name without any information given generally means that the person is living at home at the present time.
8. (Jim-de) This sign means that only the spouse of the member of the Meyer family is deceased.
9. accountant - waitress The first occupation is always the mans, while the second is the wifes. This applies only when a hyphen separates the two occupations.
