Genealogy of the Tenery family compiled by Andy Simmons Weddington
R. F. D. No. 3, Pulaski, Tenn. January, 23 1957.

From when the name originated in England until now it has been spelled many ways; Including Trenary, Tenery, and Tennery, etc. The oldest one we have learned of in this country seemed to prefer Tenery. I shall so spell it in this Genealogy hoping that will meet with the approval of other members of the family. I hope this will be interesting to any that may read it, and in order that it may be available for future generations I am going to file a copy with the State Library and Archives Nashville, Tennessee.

After thorough search I believe the names and dates to be correct, If in doubt I will place question mark. have looked over records in a number of Court Houses, talked to many people, wrote many letters, have enjoyed talking to and corresponding with many relatives that until six months ago I knew nothing about.

My sincere thanks to the many people that have helped. I wish to mention Dr. Nettie Lee Benson, Librarian at the University of Texas, Austin Texas.

I suggest you add any additional information you may have that I have omitted, also suggest that you send such information to me that I may keep my record up to date.

Also suggest you keep your copy up to date by recording all births, deaths, marriages etc.

For this Genealogy, we will begin with one William Tenery a Revolutionary soldier, who lived in Fredrick county Virginia. He married in Newtown Virginia, Sarah Bellwood, January 11, 1789, They both lived to a ripe old age, William Tenery died in Pine Township, Allegany county, Pennsylvania, January 1, 1845 at over 90 years of age.

His wife Sarah Bellwood Tenery was still living in Pennsylvania, as late as March 3, 1855. We believe that of their 10 children, the oldest William Daniel was born late in 1789.

William Daniel Tenery, came to Giles county Tennessee from East Tennessee, early in 1800 and married Nancy (Sallie or Polly) Young, near the head of Buchanan Creek in Giles county about 1814 or 15? They had the following children:

I stated on page 2 that Ruben had been suggested as the name of the eight child of William Daniel Tenery, further research by Dr. Nettie Lee Benson seems to prove that Nancy is the missing name and that she was born about 1814, therefore older than the oldest listed in this Genealogy, at the time of the 1860 census she was 46 . I know nothing further about her.

It has been a pleasure to trace the Genealogy of the Tenery family, (my first attempt at such work) ,it is inspiring to belong to a pioneering family such as this was.

Our ancestors endured hardships which we in this modern age know nothing about, they fought in all the major wars that this country has been engaged in.

Just to mention a few facts; William Tenery was a Revolutionary soldier and we have reasons to believe his country with distinction.

Thomas Jefferson Tenery served under the great General Sam Houston during a critical time in the history of our country, he received a bounty of a section of land from the state of Texas.

James Madison Tenery was a soldier during the civil war and served under the matchless chieftain, General Bedford Forest, he was General Forest's chief Veterinary Surgeon and until this day is known of around Bunker Hill Tennessee as the horse doctor.

Pleasant H. Dock Tenery lost his life while in the service of the Southland at the battle of Chickamauga.

Edwin K. P. Tenery also served with distinction on the side of the South in the Civil war. He volunteered and was a member of Company C 3rd Tennessee Infantry under Captain Dave Rhea.

He endured many hardships, having been twice taken prisoner, both times he was taken to that dreadful Northern prison, Camp Douglas, where many gallant soldiers lost their lives through hunger, cruelty and exposure. When released he made his way home on foot.

Just this brief mention of my grand father John Elisha Tenery; who was born near Bunker Hill, Tenn. and he liked to tell of incidents in his life . He remembered the early merchants of Bunker Hill,

the heavy snow of 1843. He liked to tell of the time he was making Maple sugar and a bear came up watching him, it was an uneasy feeling as he was unarmed. He had several horses stolen during the Civil war, one of which was valued at \$1000.00. They left a poor mule which he kept until it died.

I sincerely hope you get as much pleasure out of reading this as I have writing it. I would appreciate any additional information, also corrections you may send me.

As such information comes in it will be filed and when a full page accumulates it will be printed.
