

NASTASIUS UHLER, from whom the Uhler family of Central Pennsylvania spring, was born in Palatine, Germany, now Bavaria, and not very far from the Rhine. From all the information attainable, his birth-day was about 1710. He sailed from Rotterdam, via Cowes, England, in the ship "Samuel," Hugh Percy, master. All German emigrants at that time were compelled to pass into an English port, where an oath of allegiance to the Crown was exacted.

The vessel arrived at Philadelphia, August 17, 1732, but at what date he arrived at Lebanon is not known. The earliest record of his presence here is his marriage, May 3, 1737, to Dorothea Jerg (George?), appearing in the book of the Salem

Lutheran church.

The Landoffice records show that 50 acres of land were surveyed to him, April 4, 1750, in Lebanon township, Lancaster county. His name appears in the published list of taxables in 1755 and 1759, and a receipt for quit-rent for the year 1762 is in possession of the Reinoehl family.

In 1769, his name appears as constable of Lebanon

township.

The date of his death is not known, but he was probably interred in Salem Lutheran church cemetery.

2. CHRISTOPHER UHLER, 1741. Son of Anastasius, took the oath of allegiance to the United States before Esquire Thome, May 30, 1778. In the assessment rolls for 1780 he is rated with 185 acres of land.

In 1779 he served as Tax Assessor; as taxes were then enormously high, owing to the Revolution, contemporary history does not speak too kindly of him. He was one of the Commissioners of Dauphin county, which included the territory of Lebanon, for the years 1785, 1786, 1789 and 1790, and a captain of militia from 1785 to 1788. The Salem Lutheran and First Reformed churches were built by him.

On presenting the letter and stating the case, the President endorsed thereon:

"Permit this man to take the oath of allegiance, and discharge him.

A. LINCOLN."
