INTRODUCTORY SKETCH.

The Reformed Protestant Dutch Church in North-America is the oldest offspring of the Reformed Church of Holland, which was one of the earliest children of Protestantism. That Church adopted its "Confession of Faith" in 1561, just one year before the first "Articles of Religion" were set forth as the standards of the Church of England under Queen Elizabeth. While the Protestants in the Netherlands were thus establishing the religious sentiments of John Calvin, they took good care to carry out his views in regard to the instruction of the people; for, eminent as he was as a theologian, Calvin, beyond dispute, was also "the father of popular education, the inventor of the system of free schools." Accordingly, we find that neither the perils

of war, nor the pursuit of gain, nor the excitement of political strife ever caused the Calvinistic Hollanders to neglect the duty of educating their offspring to enjoy that freedom for which their fathers had fought. Schools were everywhere provided, with good schoolmasters to instruct the children of all classes in the usual branches of education, as well as in the catechism and doctrines of the Church; and the several consistories were bound to "use their best endeavors that a sufficient number of students in theology should be constantly maintained at the public expense." In 1574, during the darkest period of their war

first Dutch clergyman, began his labors there. At the same time, Adam Roelandsen, the first schoolmaster, entered upon the discharge of his duties. While New-Netherland remained a Dutch Province, education continued to receive the fostering care of the public authorities; and, in succession, Cornelissen, Vestens, Drisius, La Montagne, Van Hoboken, Pietersen, Corlaer, Curtius, and Luyck superintended the instruction of youth. The Classis of Amsterdam, from time to time, sent out educated clergymen to minister in the various congregations which had been established here; and, under the general supervision of the Synod of North-Holland, that Classis continued, for more than a century after the surrender of New-Netherland, to be the ecclesias

The Rev. Dr. Ira Condict was likewise appointed Professor of Moral Philosophy, and Dr. Robert Adrain, Professor of Mathematics. Upon the death of Dr. Condict in 1811, the Rev. Dr. John Schureman, one of the ministers of the Collegiate Church in New-York, was appointed to succeed him as Professor of Moral Philosophy and Belles-Lettres, and also acted as Vice-President of the College. In 1813, upon the resignation of Dr. Adrain, Henry Vethake, A.M., was appointed Professor of Mathematics; and in 1814, the Rev. Cornelius C. Vermeule was appointed Professor of Languages. With this able faculty, Queen's College struggled for a few years to maintain itself. But receiving no patronage from the State, its Trustees were obliged to suspend the exercises of the Literary Department in 1816.

At that time Dr. Schureman was associated with Dr. Livingston as Professor in the Theological Seminary. Upon the death of Dr. Schureman in 1818, Dr. Thomas De Witt was elected by the Synod

a year, for three years, for the support of the
Consistory at once answered favorably to the request of the Board,
upon condition that funds for the endowment of a third professorship
should be secured within the Particular Synod of Albany. This object,
chiefly through the exertions of Dr. Ludlow, who was then minister of
the North Church in Albany, was happily accomplished ; and the suc-
cessful issue was reported to the General Synod, at its adjourned session
in New-Brunswick, in September, 1825. At that session, the Commit-
tee of Synod previously appointed, consisting of Drs. Knox, Ludlow,
and Thomas De Witt, and Messrs. Hardenbergh and Heyer, report-
ed a plan for the revival of the College, (drawn up by Dr. Ludlow,) which was approved, and was the basis of a covenant entered into
between the Trustees of the College and the General Synod. It was
therein provided, among other things, that the Professors of the Theo-
logical Seminary should have such literary duties assigned them in the
College by the General Synod as the Synod should deem best calculated

to promote the mutual interest of both institutions ; that the Trustees should elect one of the Theological Professors as President ; that they should appoint a Professor of Languages and one of Mathematics and Natural Philosophy ; and that they should have the use of part of the College building which had been purchased by the Synod.

Pursuant to this covenant Queen's College was revived. Professor Milledoler was elected President of the College by the Trustees, and Professors De Witt and Woodhull, of the Theological Seminary, were assigned respectively to the chairs of Belles-Lettres and Metaphysics, by the Synod. The Trustees also appointed the Rev. Dr. W. C. Brownlee Professor of Languages and Robert Adrain, LL.D., Professor of

PRESIDENTS.

REV. JACOB R. HARDENBERGH,* D.D. Appointed, 1786 ; died, 1790.

He was the son of a gentleman of the same name, who emigrated from Prussia, early in the last century, and who became one of the original proprietors of the "Hardenbergh Patent," in the State of New-York. He was born at Rosendale, near Kingston, Ulster county, N. Y., A.D. 1738. Studied at the Kingston Academy, and completed his theological course with Domine John Frelinghuysen, at Raritan, Somerset county, N. J., and succeeded his Preceptor there in his pastoral charge. He visited Holland and other parts of Europe, and upon his return was made D.D. by the College at Princeton. Resigning his pastoral charge at Raritan, he removed to his native place, Rosendale, Ulster county. While there he was chosen President of Queen's College, and removed to New-Brunswick, becoming at the same time pastor of the Reformed Dutch church in that place. He died in the discharge of these duties in October, 1790. He was an ardent patriot in our revolutionary struggle, contributing both by his oratory and his pen to the cause of the independence of these States, and was a member of the Convention which framed the first Constitution of New-Jersey.

After the decease of Rev. Dr. HARDENBERGH, the Rev. Dr. JOHN H. LIVINGSTON was elected to the presidency of the College, but he declined. In 1791, Rev. Dr. THEODORICK ROMEYN was elected to the same office, but he also declined. Presidents *pro tempore* were then appointed for several years ; among whom were Rev. Dr. WM. LINN and Rev. Dr. IRA CONDUCT.

REV. JOHN H. LIVINGSTON,* D.D., S.T.P. Appointed, 1810 ; died, January 20, 1825.

He was the son of Henry Livingston and Sarah Conklin, born at Poughkeepsie, May 30, A.D. 1746, graduated at Yale College in July, 1762. In May, 1766, he sailed for Holland, and studied theology at Utrecht. Licensed by Classis of Amsterdam, June 5, 1769 ; made Doctor of Theology by University of Utrecht in May, 1770 ; returned to New-York September, 1770, having been ordained a pastor of the church in that city by the Classis of Amsterdam ; preached there until New-York was occupied by the British in September, 1776 ; preached at Kingston, Albany, Poughkeepsie, and neighboring places during the Revolution ; returned to New-York soon after the evacuation, November 25, 1783 ; appointed Professor of Theology by General Synod, October, 1784 ; inaugurated in the city of New-York, May 19, 1785 ; taught in New-York and Flatbush, L. I., until 1810, when he removed to New-Brunswick, N. J., having been appointed President of Queen's College. He died in New-Brunswick, 20 January, 1825.

REV. PHILIP MILLEDOLER,* D.D., LL.D., S.T.P. Appointed, 1825 ; resigned, 1840.

He was born at Rhinebeck, N. Y., September 22, A.D. 1775, the only son of John and Anna Milledoler, who had emigrated from Geneva, Switzerland, some

years before; graduated at Columbia College in 1792; ordained by the Synod of the German Reformed Church May 17, 1794; called to the German Reformed Church in Nassau street the same year; became pastor of the Third Presbyterian Church in Philadelphia in 1800; called to the Presbyterian Collegiate Church in New-York, with special care of the Rutgers-street Church, in 1805; in 1813 called to the Collegiate Reformed Dutch Church in New-York, where he remained until he was appointed Professor of Didactic Theology and President of Rutgers College in 1825. He died on Staten-Island in 1852, on his seventy-seventh birth-day.
