GENERAL ORDER, NO. 2.

HEAD QUARTERS, 11th BRIGADE TEXAS MILITIA.
PALESTINE, June 21st, 1861.

S. T. BRIDGES of Anderson county, is appointed Brigade Major, with the Rank of Major of Cavalry.

B. F. DURHAM of Anderson county, is appointed Quarter Master, with the Rank of Major of Cavalry.

All persons liable to perform Military duty and not members of any organized Company, will report to any one of the Enrolling Officers in their respective counties.

The following persons are hereby appointed Enrolling Officers for the 11th Brigade Texas Militia for

Anderson County:

As soon as each of the above named Officers shall have enrolled a sufficient number of men to constitute a company, they shall cause the men so enrolled, to organize companies by the election of a Captain, three Lieutenants, five Sergeants and five Corporals.

The Captains, so soon as elected, will forward to the Brigadier General of this District, Duplicate muster rolls of their Companies, with the certificate required by sections 10 and 12 of the above recited act of February 15th. 1858. * One of which Muster rolls the Brigadier will forward to the Office of the Adjutant General of the State, with said certificates; upon the receipt of which, Commissions shall issue to the officers.

* ART. 1470. [10] The officers of said companies shall be elected by the members of the same, in the armory of the company, and returns of the election made by the first Sergeant of the company to the Chief Justice of the county where such company is established, directed to the Governor of the State, who shall commission said officers as soon as he shall have received a certificate of election from the said Chief Justice.

ART. 1472. [12] Before any such company shall be entitled to the provisions of this act, the commanding officer present shall furnish and have recorded in the office of the County Clerk of the county in which said company may reside, a certificate under oath, showing where such company was organized, and to what arm of the service it may belong, and also the names of all its officers and members at the date of said certificate.
