The investigation into the origin of, and discussion of comparable traditions and superstitions revolving around the common myth the dying god. Human sacrifice, reincarnation, cannibalism, seasonal changes associated with death and rebirth, ritualized murder, funerary celebrations, and heirlooms and traditions to mimic such events are described in detail with conjectures to their true origin.
