IS 4787: 1968 SPECIFICATION FOR TABLE, EXAMINATION

(Page 4, clause 3.2) — Substitute the following for the existing clause:

'3.2 Top — The minimum thickness of the metal sheet used for top shall be 1.2 mm in case of mild steel or 1 mm in case of stainless steel. If top is superimposed by stainless steel, then the minimum thickness of stainless steel shall be 0.5 mm over a mild steel sheet of 0.8 mm thickness.'

(Page 5, Fig. 1) — Add the following note below Fig. 1:

O. FOREWORD

- 0.1 This Indian Standard was adopted by the Indian Standards Institution on 18 October 1968, after the draft finalized by the Hospital Equipment Sectional Committee had been approved by the Consumer Products Division Council.
- 0.2 The formulation of Indian Standards on hospital equipment has been taken up at the instance of the Advisory Committee for Development of Surgical Instruments, Equipment and Appliances, Government of India.
- **0.3**. This standard forms one of a series of Indian Standards on hospital furniture. Other standards in the series are:

IS: 4033-1968 General requirements for hospital furniture

IS: 4034-1968 Castors for hospital equipment

IS: 4035-1967 Trolleys, stretcher

IS: 4036-1967 Trolleys, patient

IS:4037-1967 Stretcher and stretcher carriers

IS: 4266-1967 Lockers, bedside for hospital use

IS: 4267-1967 Stands, wash hand basin

IS:4455-1967 Trolleys, soiled linen

IS:4458-1967 Screens, bedside

- 6.4 IS: 4033-1968* is a necessary adjunct to this standard.
- 0.5 Clause 5.1 calls for an agreement between the purchaser and the supplier.
- 0.6 For the purpose of deciding whether a particular requirement of this standard is complied with, the final value, observed or calculated, expressing the result of a test, shall be rounded off in accordance with IS: 2-1960†. The number of significant places retained in the rounded off value should be the same as that of the specified value in this standard.

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1. SCOPE

1.1 This standard specifies the requirements of examination tables used in hospitals and other similar institutions.

2. TERMINOLOGY

- 2.0 For the purpose of this standard the definition given in 2.1 shall apply.
- 2.1 Table, Examination Table used for the purpose of examination of patients in the consulting rooms, clinics and side-rooms of hospital wards.

3. MATERIALS

- 3.1 Framework This shall be according to 2.1 of IS: 4033-1968*.
- 3.2 Top This shall conform to 2.2(a) of IS: 4033-1968*.
- 3.3 Rods, Channels and Strips These shall be of mild steel, either cold-rolled or hot-rolled quality.

4. DIMENSIONS

- 4.1 The main dimensions of examination table shall be as given in Fig. 1.
- 4.2 The thickness of tubes used and their corresponding outside diameters for different parts shall be as given below:



4.3 The mild steel sheet used for top and head rest shall have a minimum thickness of 1.22 mm.

5. MANUFACTURE

5.1 Framework — The examination table shall have a framework of single continuous lengths of mild steel tubes as shown in Fig. 1. At the floor end, the four upright members shall be connected together by longitudinal and transverse tie rods and at the other end these shall support a formed sheet metal top. For receiving the sheet metal top, the top ends of the uprights shall be flattened and thereafter welded to the top. Any other arrangement of fixing the sheet metal top to the framework shall be agreed to by the purchaser and the manufacturer, but in either case the top so obtained shall be sturdy in construction. The head rest shall have the same construction as the top and it shall be adjustable on a rack for obtaining

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various positions. The floor ends of the upright members or legs shall be fitted with metal shoes. The rest of the details shall be according to 4 of IS:4033-1968*.

6. FINISH

6.1 The requirements as specified in 5 of IS: 4033-1968* shall apply.

7. TESTS

- 7.1 Adhesion Test This shall conform to 6.1.1 of IS: 4033-1968*.
- 7.2 Performance Test—The head rest shall stand the test given in 7.2.1 in various positions obtained by adjusting the rack.
- 7.2.1 In any positition of head rest, with a load of 25 kgf spread over the entire width of head rest, there shall be no excessive sideways play and also the head rest shall be stable.

8. MARKING

8.1 The marking shall be as specified in 7 of IS: 4033-1968*.

9. PACKING

9.1 The packing shall be as specified in 8 of IS: 4033-1968*.
