

MOTION TO CONTINUE

Comes Now the Defendant, through his attorney, Luke A. Evans and moves this Honorable Court for a continuance of his sentencing hearing currently scheduled for October 11, 2013. In support of this request, the Defendant states as follows:

1. The Defendant is set for trial in different matter, namely *U.S. v. Manila Vichitvongsa*, et al. 3:12-00013, before Judge Campbell on November 12, 2013. In that case Mr. Vichitvongsa is charged in an eight count indictment, along with seven co-defendants, with multiple violations of 18 U.S.C. §§1951 and 2, 18 U.S.C. §§ 924(c) and 2 and 21 U.S.C. §§ 846 and 2. The alleged conduct that led to this indictment will undoubtedly be pursued by the Government in the sentencing hearing in this case as relevant conduct that bears on the Defendant's sentence.
