16 Respondents Daniel and Mary Lee Johnson are hereby notified that the United States has  
17 petitioned this Court for an Order allowing the Internal Revenue Service to levy upon the real

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23 This Court has examined the Petition of the United States and accompanying Declaration  
24 of Revenue Officer Steve Baker, and it is hereby ORDERED that Respondents have 25 days  
25 from the date of this Order to file with the Clerk of the Court a written Objection to Petition.  
26 Any written Objection to Petition should demonstrate either that:

1 A. The liability has been satisfied; or

2 B. Respondents have other assets from which the unpaid tax liabilities can be  
3 satisfied; or

4 C. Applicable laws and administrative procedures relevant to the levy were not  
5 followed by the Internal Revenue Service.  
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7 It is FURTHER ORDERED that if Respondents file a written Objection to Petition with  
8 the Clerk of Court, then the Court will hold a hearing, at which the parties must appear, on  
9 **November 10<sup>th</sup>, 2009, at 10:00 a.m.**, at the United States Courthouse, 1717 Pacific Avenue,  
10 Tacoma, Washington, 98402, in Courtroom D, for the court to consider Respondents' objections.

11 It is FURTHER ORDERED that, in addition to filing any Objection to the Petition with

27 If Respondents do not file an Objection to Petition within 25 days of service of this order, or if he  
28 files an Objection to Petition but fails to appear before the Court as instructed, the Court will  
29 enter an Order Approving an Internal Revenue Service Levy on the Real Property Located at  
30 9507 131st Street N.W., Gig Harbor, Washington 98329.

1 It is FURTHER ORDERED that a copy of this ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE, together  
2 with the Petition and Declaration, shall be served upon Respondents Daniel and Mary Lee  
3 Johnson within 5 days of the date of this Order, by a Revenue Officer of the Internal Revenue


