AMENDMENT

In response to the Office Action dated October 24, 1985, please amend as follows:

IN THE SPECIFICATION:

REMARKS

The above amendment merely corrects a typographical omission.

Claims 1 to 8 and 11 to 19 stand rejected under 35 USC 103 over Northey (3,359,983) or Listner (3,630,205). The rejection is respectfully traversed and withdrawal is solicited.

The Examiner in the above Action states as follows:

"While the references do not specifically state that the filament is a "hard elastic" filament, it has the same properties as that of the instant claims and was prepared in the same manner."

Applicant disagrees that either the same properties or the same manner of preparation is described in Northey or Listner.
