1. (Amended) A device for retaining a prosthesis within a body passage having a diameter, comprising a[n] substantially annular, resilient element, said element being movable between an undeformed state wherein said element has [with] an undeformed diameter greater than the diameter of said body passage, and a deformed state wherein said element is partially folded and has a diameter smaller than when in said undeformed state, said element being in said deformed state when retaining said prosthesis in said body passage.
