DETAILED ACTION

1. The newly amended claims, filed 2/7/2008, based on the options provided by the Board of Patent Appeals and Interferences, dated 11/20/2007 place the application in allowable condition.

Allowable Subject Matter

2. Claims 11 – 14 and 22 – 29, renumbered as 1 - 12 are allowed.

3. The following is an examiner's statement of reasons for allowance: The prior art of the record fails to anticipate or fairly suggest, a method of transmitting a bit-stream representing digitalized images to a user which requires a reduction of the bit stream, the method comprising: encoding digitalized images in a compressed discrete cosine transform (DCT) domain using DCTs of length $N/2$, to produce a first encoded bit-stream of coefficients; receiving in a transcoder the first encoded bit stream; under-sampling in the transcoder, by removing selected ones of the coefficients, the compressed digitalized images represented by the first encoded bit-stream by a certain factor in each dimension; and calculating, from the remaining coefficients, DCTs of length $N \times N$, each of the DCTs of length $N \times N$ calculated directly from four adjacent DCT coefficient blocks of size $N/2 \times N/2$ of the remaining coefficients, for each of the digitalized images, N being a positive, even integer to produce a second encoded bit-stream; and transmitting from the transcoder the second encoded bit stream to the user, as specifies in independent claim 11, renumbered as claim 1, and similar limitations in independent claims 12, 22 – 23, 25 and 26, renumbered as claims 2, 5 – 6, 8 and 9.

Claims 13 – 14, 24 and 27 – 29, renumbered as claims 3 – 4, 7 and 10 - 12, are dependent to allowable renumbered independent claims 1 – 2, 5 – 6 and 8 – 9, and as a whole consider allowable.
