The Applicant wishes to begin addressing MPEP §512 Certificate of Mailing or Transmission, PROCEDURE BY APPLICANT (C) (with reference to proper use of a Certificate of Mailing under 37 CFR §1.8), reproduced as follows:

-- When the certification is presented on a separate sheet, that sheet <u>must</u> (1) be signed and (2) fully identify and be securely attached to the paper it accompanies. The required identification <u>should</u> include the application number and filing date of the application as well as the type of paper being filed, e.g., reply to rejection or refusal, Notice of Appeal, etc. An unsigned certification will not be considered acceptable. Moreover, without the <u>proper identifying data</u>, a certification presented on a separate sheet will not be considered acceptable if there is any question or doubt concerning the connection between the sheet and the paper filed. If the sheet should become detached from the paper and thereafter not associated with the appropriate file, evidence that this sheet was received in the Office can be supported by submitting a copy of a postcard receipt specifically identifying this sheet and the paper and by submitting a copy of the sheet as originally mailed. Attention is directed to MPEP § 503 relative to the use of postcards as receipts. -- (emphasis added).\footnote{1}

The Applicant respectfully acknowledges that the MPEP states that the certification <u>must</u> be signed and fully identify the paper it accompanies. The Applicant also respectfully points out, as indicated in items 3 and 4 of the declaration presented herewith, that Moira Selinka securely attached the executed Certificate of Mailing (Exhibit I) to the Amendment and fully identified each submitted paper by "Amendment

The Applicant further acknowledges that, although "Amendment, 3-month Extension of Time, and Form PTO 1449 and 2 references" were unambiguously stated, the Certificate of Mailing should have included the application number and filing date of the application.
