## **REMARKS**

To further prosecution of this application, Claims 1-45 have been canceled without prejudice or disclaimer. Claim 46 remains in this application for examination. This is not an acquiescence to any ground of rejection. Applicant reserves the right to pursue the canceled subject matter in continuing applications.

As indicated on Page 7 of the specification (the paragraph immediately preceding Example 2), the hybridoma cell line producing CMY-2 antibody was deposited with the German Collection of Microorganisms and Cell Cultures (DSMZ - Deutsche Sammlung von Mikroorganismen und Zellkulturen GmbH). This deposit was made in accordance with 37 CFR 1.801-1.809, and under the Budapest Treaty. All restrictions imposed by the depositor on the availability to the public of the deposited material will be irrevocably removed (with the possible exception of requiring the request for the deposit to be in the format specified in 37 CFR 1.808(b)). See, M.PE.P. 2404.01.
