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DETAILED ACTION

Election/Restrictions

- 1. Restriction to one of the following inventions is required under 35 U.S.C. 121:
 - Claims 9-20, 29-40, and 49-60, drawn to client accessing a remote host, classified in class 709, subclass 219 (accessing a remote server).
 - II. Claims 21-28, 41-48, and 61-68, drawn to a host setting parameters from a remote client, classified in class 709, subclass 228 (session/connection parameter setting).

The inventions are distinct, each from the other because of the following reasons:

- 2. Inventions I and II are related as subcombinations disclosed as usable together in a single combination. The subcombinations are distinct from each other if they are shown to be separately usable. In the instant case, invention I has separate utility such as accessing any remote host and displaying images from a host. See MPEP § 806.05(d).
- 3. Because these inventions are distinct for the reasons given above and the search required for Group I is not required for Group II, restriction for examination purposes as indicated is proper.
- 4. Because these inventions are distinct for the reasons given above and the search required for Group II is not required for Group I, restriction for examination purposes as indicated is proper.
