DETAILED ACTION

The application has been amended as follows:

Claims 1-49 canceled.

Claim 50,

A computer-implemented method comprising:

receiving, by a toolbox from a merchant computer, an IP address and an inquiry whether a user computer is online at the IP address;

confirming, by the toolbox, that the user computer is online at the IP address, wherein the confirming comprises,

transmitting a file to the IP address;

receiving acceptance of an online purchase from the user computer by receiving, based on the transmission of the file, identification information of the user computer;

verifying the identification information of the user computer;

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determining that a credit limit associated with a user of the user computer is not exceeded; and
sending, based on the determining, a confirmation of the online purchase to the merchant computer.

Claim 51.

The computer-implemented method of claim 50, wherein the toolbox is located within an internet service provider.

Claim 52.

The computer-implemented method of claim 50, wherein the toolbox is located outside an internet service provider.

Claim 53

The computer-implemented method of claim 50, wherein the identification of the user computer identifies one or more components of the user computer.

Claim 54

The computer-implemented method of claim 50, wherein the identification of the user computer includes one or more of a central processor unit identification number, hard disk serial number, amount of random access memory, and basic input/output system version.

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Claim 55

One or more machine-readable storage medium including instructions which, when executed by one or more machines, cause the one or more machines to perform operations comprising:

receiving, by a toolbox from a merchant computer, an IP address and an inquiry whether a user computer is online at the IP address;

confirming, by the toolbox, that the user computer is online at the IP address, wherein the confirming comprises,

transmitting a file to the IP address;

receiving acceptance of an online purchase from the user computer by receiving, based on the transmission of the file, identification information of the user computer;

verifying the identification information of the user computer;

determining that a credit limit associated with a user of the user computer is not exceeded; and

sending, based on the determining, a confirmation of the online purchase to the merchant computer.

Claim 56.

The machine-readable storage medium of claim 55, wherein the toolbox is located within an internet service provider.

Claim 57.

The computer-implemented method of claim 55, wherein the toolbox is located outside an internet service provider.

Claim 58.

The computer-implemented method of claim 55, wherein the identification of the user computer identifies one or more components of the user computer.

Claim 59.

The computer-implemented method of claim 55, wherein the identification information of the user computer includes one or more of a central processor unit identification number, hard disk serial number, amount of random access memory, and basic input/output system version.

Claim 60

A system comprising:

a processor and memory,

the memory containing instructions that when executed by the processor performs operations including,

receiving, by a toolbox from a merchant computer, an IP address and an inquiry whether a user computer is online at the IP address;

confirming, by the toolbox, that the user computer is online at the IP address, wherein the confirming comprises,

transmitting a file to the IP address;

receiving acceptance of an online purchase from the user computer by receiving, based on the transmission of the file, identification information of the user computer;

verifying the identification information of the user computer;

determining that a credit limit associated with a user of the user computer is not exceeded; and

Claim 61.

The system of claim 60, wherein the toolbox is located within an internet service provider.

Claim 62.

The system of claim 60, wherein the toolbox is located outside an internet service provider.

Claim 63.

The system of claim 60, wherein the identification of the user computer identifies one or more components of the user computer.

Claim 64.

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The system of claim 60, wherein the identification information of the user computer includes one or more of a central processor unit identification number, hard disk serial number, amount of random access memory, and basic input/output system version.

Allowable Subject Matter

2. Claims 50-64 are allowed over the prior art record.

The following is an examiner's statement of reasons for allowance:

The closest prior art of record Padgett et al (US Patent 6,167,518) discloses a A digital certificate is formed from a digitized representation of a unique biological feature of a registrant.

3. As per claims 50, 55 and 60 none of the art of record, taken individually or combination disclose at least the steps/components of:

receiving acceptance of an online purchase from the user computer by receiving, based on the transmission of the file, identification information of the user computer; verifying the identification information of the user computer; determining that a credit limit associated with a user of the user computer is not exceeded; and sending, based on the determining, a confirmation of the online purchase to the merchant computer.

4. Claims 50, 55 and 60 are allowable for the above cited reasons.

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Claims 51-54, 56-59 and 61-64 are dependant upon claims 50, 55 and 60 respectively and are therefore allowable for at least the same reasons.
