## DETAILED ACTION

1. This Office Action is the answer to the Amendment filed on April 24, 2006, which paper has been placed of record in the file.

2. Claims 1-10 are pending in this application.

## **Quayle Action**

3. This application is in condition for allowance except for the following formal matters:

The drawings are objected to under 37 CFR 1.83(a). The drawings must show every feature of the invention specified in the claims. The features "pMOS and nMOS transistors are driven such that they do not have intermediate resistance simultaneously during a change of state of the CMOS structure; generating continuous circuit noise to a tamper detection line an driving the conventional CMOS structures from the tamper detection line; driving the conventional CMOS multiple times faster than the nonflashing CMOS" recited in claims 1-4, and "a noise generator connected to the conventional CMOS inverters; a tamper detection line connected between the noise generator and the conventional CMOS structures; the conventional CMOS is driven multiple times faster than the non-flashing CMOS" recited in claims 6-8, are not shown in the drawings. Therefore, these features must be shown or the features canceled from the claims. No new matter should be entered.

Corrected drawing sheets in compliance with 37 CFR 1.121(d) are required in reply to the Office action to avoid abandonment of the application. Any amended

replacement drawing sheet should include all of the figures appearing on the immediate prior version of the sheet, even if only one figure is being amended. The figure or figure number of an amended drawing should not be labeled as "amended." If a drawing figure is to be canceled, the appropriate figure must be removed from the replacement sheet, and where necessary, the remaining figures must be renumbered and appropriate changes made to the brief description of the several views of the drawings for consistency. Additional replacement sheets may be necessary to show the renumbering of the remaining figures. Each drawing sheet submitted after the filing date of an application must be labeled in the top margin as either "Replacement Sheet" or "New Sheet" pursuant to 37 CFR 1.121(d). If the changes are not accepted by the examiner, the applicant will be notified and informed of any required corrective action in the next Office action. The objection to the drawings will not be held in abeyance.

4. Prosecution on the merits is closed in accordance with the practice under *Ex parte Quayle*, 1935 C.D. 11, 453 O.G. 213.
