## **DETAILED ACTION**

## Allowable Subject Matter

1. Claims 1-14 and 26 (renumbered 1-15 respectively) are allowed.

The following is an examiner's statement of reasons for allowance:

The prior art of record fails to show or fairly suggest a plurality of head-end controllers coupled to each server module of said plurality of server module via at least two signal paths, wherein each communication between a head-end controller and a server module is coincidentally sent through the at least two signal paths (emphasis added) as claimed in Claim 1. The closest prior art of record is Adiga et al (5,892,913). Adiga shows a plurality of head end controllers and server modules (fig. 3) but fails to show that each communication between the controllers and server modules is sent between two signal paths.
