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DETAILED ACTION

Allowable Subject Matter

1. Claims 10-14, 16-23, 25-27 and 80-83 allowed

Double Patenting

2. The nonstatutory double patenting rejection is based on a judicially created doctrine grounded in public policy (a policy reflected in the statute) so as to prevent the unjustified or improper timewise extension of the "right to exclude" granted by a patent and to prevent possible harassment by multiple assignees. See *In re Goodman*, 11 F.3d 1046, 29 USPQ2d 2010 (Fed. Cir. 1993); *In re Longi*, 759 F.2d 887, 225 USPQ 645 (Fed. Cir. 1985); *In re Van Ornum*, 686 F.2d 937, 214 USPQ 761 (CCPA 1982); *In re Vogel*, 422 F.2d 438, 164 USPQ 619 (CCPA 1970); and, *In re Thorington*, 418 F.2d 528, 163 USPQ 644 (CCPA 1969).

A timely filed terminal disclaimer in compliance with 37 CFR 1.321(c) may be used to overcome an actual or provisional rejection based on a nonstatutory double patenting ground provided the conflicting application or patent is shown to be commonly owned with this application. See 37 CFR 1.130(b).

Effective January 1, 1994, a registered attorney or agent of record may sign a terminal disclaimer. A terminal disclaimer signed by the assignee must fully comply with 37 CFR 3.73(b).

3. Claims 68-71 and 76-79 rejected under the judicially created doctrine of obviousness-

type double patenting as being unpatentable over claims 1,6,13, 16, 17, 18, 23-25, 30, 37, 40 and

41 of Patent No 6,469,317. Although the conflicting claims are not identical, they are not

patentably distinct from each other because they both claim gate electrode, gate wiring and

channel forming regions where the conductive layers for the gate electrode and gate wiring are

made of different materials and where the gate wiring is formed outside the channel forming

region.

This is a <u>provisional</u> obviousness-type double patenting rejection because the conflicting claims have not in fact been patented.
