## **DETAILED ACTION**

## Claim Rejections - 35 USC § 112

The following is a quotation of the first paragraph of 35 U.S.C. 112:

The specification shall contain a written description of the invention, and of the manner and process of making and using it, in such full, clear, concise, and exact terms as to enable any person skilled in the art to which it pertains, or with which it is most nearly connected, to make and use the same and shall set forth the best mode contemplated by the inventor of carrying out his invention.

Claims 7, 8, 10 and 18-20 are rejected under 35 U.S.C. 112, first paragraph, as failing to comply with the enablement requirement. The claim(s) contains subject matter which was not described in the specification in such a way as to enable one skilled in the art to which it pertains, or with which it is most nearly connected, to make and/or use the invention.

The specification shows *in vitro* results using the claimed extract to induce the expression of a phase II enzyme but not *in vivo* as is claimed. The claims require that the induction of the expression of a phase II enzyme happen <u>in a subject</u> in need thereof. Thus, without support to show that the claimed extract has indeed been administered to a subject in need thereof, i.e. *in vivo*, the claims are not enabled by the instant specification.

In addition, the art of record shows that it was not known to administer the claimed extract to induce the expression of the phase II enzymes to a subject in need

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thereof as claimed. Thus, this established the unpredictability in the art of the claimed invention.
