<u>REMARKS</u>

Claims 1 and 3-17 were previously pending in this application. By this amendment, Applicant is canceling claims 4 and 12 without prejudice or disclaimer. Claims 1, 3, and 5 have been amended. As a result claims 1, 3, 5-11 and 13-17 are pending for examination with claims 1, 3, 16 and 17 being independent claims. No new matter has been added.

The Office Action rejected claim 3 under 35 U.S.C. §102(b) as being anticipated by U.S. Patent No. 3,584,132 to Brauns et al. (hereinafter Brauns).

The Office Action rejected claim 1 under 35 U.S.C. §103(a) as being unpatentable over Brauns in view of U.S. Patent No. 5,841,072 to Gagnon.

The Office Action objected to claims 4-15 as being dependant upon a rejected base claim but indicated that these claims would be allowable if rewritten in independent from. The Office Action noted that the structure of claim 4, wherein the first assembly is closer to a conductor of the second assembly than to an outer surface opposite the conductor, was not taught or suggested by the prior art.

Applicant has amended claims 1 and 3 to incorporate the subject matter of claim 4 and has cancelled claim 4. All claims should now be in condition for allowance. Accordingly, withdrawal of the rejections and allowance of all claims is respectfully requested.

1. A twisted pair cable comprising a plurality of pairs, each of said pairs comprising:

two assemblies, a first assembly comprising:

a <u>first</u> conductor, <u>said first conductor being closer to a second conductor of a second assembly then to an outer surface opposite said conductors;
 an inner insulator surrounding the <u>first conductor;</u>

an outer insulator surrounding the inner insulator;

an inner edge of the first assembly defined by a surface of the first assembly closest to a second assembly in the same pair; and

an outer edge of the first assembly defined by a surface of the first assembly farthest from the second assembly in the same pair, the outer edge of the first assembly being farther from the <u>first</u> conductor than the inner edge of the first assembly over the length of the pair.

3. A twisted pair cable comprising a plurality of pairs, each of said pairs comprising:

two conductor assemblies, a first assembly comprising:

a <u>first</u> conductor, <u>said first conductor being closer to a second conductor of a</u> second assembly than to an outer surface opposite said conductors;

at least one layer of insulator surrounding the first conductor;

an inner edge of the first assembly defined by a surface of the first assembly closest to a second conductor assembly in the same pair; and

an outer edge of the first assembly defined by a surface of the first assembly farthest from the second conductor assembly in the same pair[, the outer edge of the first assembly being farther from the conductor than the inner edge of the first assembly over the length of the pair]. 5. A twisted pair cable according to claim [4] <u>1</u>, wherein said inner insulator is an extrudable polymer, and wherein said outer insulator is an extrudable elastomer.
