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4. Further comments:

Claims 1-4, 9-10, 15, 17, 18-20, 25-26, 29-30, 32-35, 40-43, all recite SEQ ID Nos which were unable to be searched because the CRF disk provided has errors. Please see attached error report.

Claims 5-8, etc all depend upon the above claims and are unsearchable as such. The particular amino acid ranges recited in claim 1 for example, are unsearchable without the sequence information.

The terms "TACI" is an arbitrary lab designations and the search results obtained from searching this term would pull up unrelated hits that would not be meaningful.

The terms "IgG1 Fc", "CH2", "CH3", "transmembrane activator", "calcium modulator" are art recognized term, but absent additional limitations, such as structure provided by sequence information, the search results of these terms would not be meaningful because of the large number of hits that result from such a search.
