REASONS FOR ALLOWANCE

2. These comments are made in addition to the remarks in Applicant's specification and arguments, concerning the manner in which the invention distinguishes from the art discussed therein. Based on Applicants' arguments, the Examiner notes that the prior art does not disclose or suggest the claimed combination including particularly a currency evaluation device which receives stacks of currency bills and evaluates all bills in the stack, said device having an input receptacle, two or more output receptacles, a transport mechanism which transports bills one at a time from the input to any or all of the output receptacles, a discriminator to discriminate bills, said discriminator positioned along the transport path of said bills, and a processor programmed to determine if a bill meets or fails to meet a non-piece count related criterion, causing the processor to halt the transport mechanism in response to a bill either meeting or failing the criterion, such a bill being termed a "flagged bill", the processor halting the transport mechanism with

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the flagged bill being positioned as the last bill in the stack in one of the receptacles.

The Examiner is construing non-piece count criterion to be defined as including all of the "minor errors", as described in the specification from p. 29, line 10 through p. 32, line 28. The device is considered to have a processor programmed to handle all of these "minor error" situations. The prior art lacks this structure or anything equivalent to it. In addition, each of the independent claims transports the "flagged bill" in a manner not described in the prior art.
