Applicants hereby submit this request for continued examination ("RCE") requesting consideration of an Amendment in Response To August 10, 2002 Final Office Action which applicants submitted to the United States Patent and Trademark Office on December 10, 2002 in connection with the above-identified patent application.

On February 10, 2003, applicants filed a Notice of Appeal From The Examiner's Decision To The Board Of Patent Appeals And Interferences And A Petition For An Additional Two-Month Extension Of Time. 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With a one-month extension of time, an Appeal Brief is now due on May 14, 2003.



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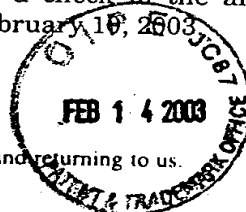
