

REMARKS

By this amendment, claims 1, 5, 13 and 18 are amended. Currently, claims 1-23 are pending in the application, of which claims 2-4, 6-8 and 14-17 are withdrawn from further consideration. Accordingly, claims 1, 5, 9-13 and 18-23 are currently active in this application, of which claims 1, 5 and 18 are independent. Applicant respectfully submits that the above amendments do not add new matter to the application and are fully supported by the specification.

Entry of this Amendment is respectfully requested because it places the present application in condition for allowance, or in the alternative, better form for appeal. In view of the above Amendments and the following Remarks, Applicant respectfully requests reconsideration and withdrawal of the objections and rejections for the reasons discussed below.

Objection to the Drawings

The drawings were objected to for failing to show every feature of the invention specified in the claims. Particularly, the Examiner stated that the drawings do not show "a printed circuit board (PCB) *attached* to the LCD panel" in claims 1, 5 and 18. This objection is respectfully traversed.

In this response, claims 1, 5 and 18 are amended to read "a printed circuit board (PCB) *coupled between* the information processing module and the LCD panel." An example of this claimed feature is shown in Fig. 8, in which the LCD driving circuit 537 is coupled between the information processing module 540 and the LCD panel 531.

Upon amending claims 1, 5 and 18, it is submitted that the drawings show every feature of the invention specified in the claims. Accordingly, Applicant respectfully requests withdrawal of the objection to the drawing.

Objection to the Claims

Claim 13 was objected to for informality therein. This objection is respectfully traversed because, in this response, claim 13 is amended to delete "monitor" in the preamble, as suggested by the Examiner. Accordingly, Applicant respectfully requests withdrawal of the objection to claim 13. This amendment is not made for the purpose of avoiding prior art or narrowing the claimed invention, and no change in claim scope is intended. Therefore, Applicant does not intend to relinquish any subject matter by these amendments.

Rejection of Claims under 35 U.S.C. §112, First Paragraph

Claims 1, 5, 9-13 and 18-23 stand rejected under 35 U.S.C. §112, first paragraph as failing to comply with the written description requirement. Particularly, the Examiner stated that the originally filed disclosure does not support "a printed circuit board (PCB) *attached* to the LCD panel" in claims 1, 5 and 18. Applicant respectfully traverses this rejection for at least the following reasons.

As mentioned above, claims 1, 5 and 18 have been amended to read "a printed circuit board (PCB) *coupled between* the information processing module and the LCD panel." An example of this claimed feature is shown in Fig. 8, in which the LCD driving circuit 537 is coupled between the information processing module 540 and the LCD

panel 531. Upon amending claims 1, 5 and 18, it is submitted that this application complies with the written description requirement.

Accordingly, Applicant respectfully requests withdrawal of the 35 U.S.C. §112, first paragraph rejection of claims 1, 5, 9-13 and 18-23.


Conclusion
