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The final rejection mailed April 26, 2006 is hereby withdrawn.

The reissue oath/declaration filed Oct. 26, 2006 is defective because it fails to identify at least one error which is relied upon to support the reissue application. See 37 CFR 1.175(a)(1) and MPEP § 1414. The reissue oath/declaration fails to identify a single word, phrase, or expression in an original claim that makes the claim indefinite or inconsistent. See MPEP 1414 section II.

Claims 1-7 are rejected as being based upon a defective reissue declaration under 35 U.S.C. 251 as set forth above. See 37 CFR 1.175.

The nature of the defect(s) in the declaration is set forth in the discussion above in this Office action.

Claims 1 and 2 are rejected under 35 U.S.C. 102(a) as being anticipated by Applicant's Disclosure. Initially, it is noted that 35 U.S.C. 112, sixth paragraph has not been invoked by the terms "engagement means", "spring means", "release means" and "attachment means" because the phrase "means for" was not used (M.P.E.P. 2181 I). Applicant admits that the rongeur shown in figures 1A-1D is prior art. This prior art rongeur comprises a front handle piece 106, bottom shaft piece 102 having a shaft portion (at the end of the lead line for reference numeral 102)

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
and a handle portion 118, engagement means 116, 117, top shaft cutting piece 101, spring means 107, 108, wherein release means permits the top shaft cutting piece 101 to open from the front to allow access for cleaning (That is, when the handles 106, 118 are released, the top shaft cutting piece 101 slides proximally to the open position shown in figure 1A which inherently allows access for cleaning.), and wherein the top shaft cutting piece 101, when so opened, remains attached by attachment means 112, 113, 114, 115 to the remainder of the rongeur.

Claims 3-7 are free of any rejection based upon the prior art of record.
