In response to the Office Action mailed August 2, 2001 ("Office Action"), please amend the application as set forth below:

In the claims:

Amend claims 11 and 16 as follows:

- B1
- 11. A method of determining whether a subject with squamous cell carcinoma does not have a lymph node containing cancerous cells, the method comprising:
 - determining a level of maspin gene expression in a biological sample from a subject with squamous cell carcinoma; and
 - comparing the level with a threshold level of maspin gene expression, wherein a level of maspin gene expression in the biological sample above the threshold level indicates that the subject does not have a lymph node containing cancerous cells.
