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Allowable Subject Matter

1. Claims 1-12 are allowed.

2. The following is an Examiner's Statement of Reasons for Allowance:

In interpreting the claims, in light of applicants' arguments filed September 27, 2004 and the specification, the Examiner finds the claimed invention to be patentably distinct from the prior art of record. The Examiner finds applicants arguments to be persuasive. Specifically, the applicants argued in substance that the prior art of record fails to teach a BIOS operative to "…add a predetermined number of MIME headers to the registry that identify the user computer systems…transfer the MIME headers in [http] request to the server computer...[resulting in] receiving service content from the service computer is the MIME headers were transferred..."

The prior art teaches a system and method comprising a BIOS for booting up an Internet radio device using applications which interface the system to the Internet (e.g. Boys, US Pat. App. No. 2001/0048677, paragraphs 0051-0056), however, the prior art fails to teach a system and method comprising a BIOS comprising an Internet agent operative to "...add a predetermined number of MIME headers to the registry that identify the user computer systems...transfer the MIME headers in [http] request to the server computer...[resulting in] receiving service content from the service computer is the MIME headers were transferred...," said Internet agent that "functions to add a predetermined number of MIME headers to the registry to identify the respective user computer system, and that changes a default web page of the web browser of the respective user computer system to point to a web page on the server computer."

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3.
