DETAILED ACTION

EXAMINER'S AMENDMENT

1. An examiner's amendment to the record appears below. Should the changes and/or additions be unacceptable to applicant, an amendment may be filed as provided by 37 CFR 1.312. To ensure consideration of such an amendment, it MUST be submitted no later than the payment of the issue fee.

Authorization for this examiner's amendment was given in a telephone interview with John P. Darling (Reg. No. 44,482) on 22 April 2004.

The application has been amended as follows:

- (1) Page 9, line 24, "45E" has been replaced by --45°--.
- (2) Claim 15, line 5, --table-- has been inserted after "object".
- (3) Claim 15, line 9, "tables" has been replaced by --table--.

Allowable Subject Matter

- 2. Claims 1-16, 18, 20, 21, 24, 27, 30, and 33 are allowed.
- 3. The following is an examiner's statement of reasons for allowance:

With respect to claims 1-10 and 21, the prior art fails to teach or fairly suggest a lithographic projection apparatus comprising a radiation source mounted on a reference frame, a two-dimensional radiation detector mounted in a fixed position on the reference frame, and a mirroring device mounted on one of the object tables that is movable relative to the reference frame so as to reflect radiation emitted by the radiation source toward the radiation detector,

the movable object table as claimed.

wherein the radiation source and the two-dimensional radiation detector are mounted to the reference frame so that a radiation beam from the radiation source is incident at 45° relative to

With respect to claim 11, the prior art fails to teach or fairly suggest a lithographic projection apparatus comprising a combiner, which combines output signals from the incremental position sensing device and the position measuring device to determine an absolute position of the object table in the detection range as claimed.

With respect to claims 12-14 and 24, the prior art fails to teach or fairly suggest a method of manufacturing a device comprising determining a reference position of the object table relative to a reference frame by: detecting the reflected radiation in a two-dimensional radiation detector mounted in a fixed position on the reference frame, wherein the radiation source and the two-dimensional radiation detector are mounted to the reference frame so that a radiation beam from the radiation source is incident at 45° relative to the movable object table as claimed.

With respect to claims 15 and 27, the prior art fails to teach or fairly suggest a position measuring device comprising a radiation source mounted on a reference frame, a two-dimensional radiation detector mounted in a fixed position on the reference frame, and a mirroring device mounted on an object that is movable relative to the reference frame so as to reflect radiation emitted by the radiation source toward the radiation detector, wherein the radiation source and the two-dimensional radiation detector are mounted to the reference frame so that a radiation beam from the radiation source is incident at 45° relative to the movable object table as claimed.

With respect to claim 16 and 30, the prior art fails to teach or fairly suggest a method of determining a reference position of a movable object table comprising detecting the reflected radiation in a two-dimensional radiation detector mounted on a fixed position on the reference frame, wherein the radiation source and the two-dimensional radiation detector are mounted to the reference frame so that a radiation beam from the radiation source is incident at 45° relative to the movable object table as claimed.

With respect to claims 18, 20, and 33, the prior art fails to teach or fairly suggest a lithographic projection apparatus comprising a position system including three position measuring devices, each position measuring device comprising a radiation source mounted on a reference frame, a two-dimensional radiation detector mounted in a fixed position on the reference frame, and a mirroring device mounted on one of the object tables that is movable relative to the reference frame so as to reflect radiation emitted by the radiation source toward the radiation detector, wherein the radiation source and the two-dimensional radiation detector are mounted to the reference frame so that a radiation beam from the radiation source is incident at 45° relative to the movable object table as claimed.
