### DECLARATION OF MARINA F. CUNNINGHAM IN SUPPORT OF PETITION TO OBTAIN EARLIER DATE OF RECEIPT OF 35 U.S.C. § 371(c)(1), (c)(2) AND (c)(4) REQUIREMENTS, AND DATE OF RECEIPT OF ALL 35 U.S.C. REQUIREMENTS

SIR:

This is a Declaration in support of the Petition to Obtain Earlier Date of Receipt of 35 U.S.C. § 371(c)(1), (c)(2) and (c)(4) Requirements, and Date of Receipt of All 35 U.S.C. Requirements. The sequence of events is as follows:

1. My name is Marina F. Cunningham. I am a partner at McCormick, Paulding & Huber LLP, and am the attorney of record in the above-identified matter.

2. The above-identified application was filed on January 11, 2001 via Express Mail.

3. After a number of attempts to determine status of the application via telephone, we filed a Status Request on February 28, 2002. In response to our Status Request, we received a Notice of Abandonment (Exhibit A).

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4. Our firm filed on May 15, 2002 a Petition to Withdraw Holding of Abandonment Based on Failure to Receive the Notification of Missing Requirements (First Petition), along with an Accompanying Declaration in support of the Petition (First Declaration) in the above-identified patent application. A copy of the First Petition and accompanying First Declaration is attached as Exhibit B to this present Petition.

5. A number of calls were made to the USPTO prior to July 9, 2002. Mr. Derek Woods of the USPTO informed me on July 9, 2002, that the Petition to Withdraw Holding of Abandonment was not received. A copy of the Petition was faxed to the USPTO (Exhibit C).

7. Numerous phone calls were placed to the USPTO by me and various conversations with Mr. Daniel Stemmer and Ms. Erin Pender took place in an attempt to determine status of the application and expedite petition process.

8. A further Status Request was filed on November 6, 2002 stating that this was Applicant's third request for a status update throughout the application process. A copy of the Status Request of November 6, 2002 and a copy of the stamped accompanying postcard receipt dated November 14, 2002 is attached as Exhibit E to this present Petition.

9. My Legal Assistant, Elizabeth Dudek, phoned the PCT Help Desk on January 14, 2003 and spoke with Paul Bell, PCT Special Programs Examiner, in order to determine to whom the next status request should be addressed since our firm had not yet received a response to our previous status requests. Mr. Bell informed Ms. Dudek that our Petition to Withdraw Holding of Abandonment had been granted on September 24, 2002 and that the application was passed to the Examiner in charge of the case. Ms. Dudek informed Mr. Bell that a copy of the grant notice had not been received by our firm. Mr. Bell indicated that he could not provide us with a copy of

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the grant notice since the application was with the Examiner. Mr. Bell further indicated that the Examiner (not identified) should be forwarding the Notice of Acceptance within the next week.



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


