DETAILED ACTION

Allowable Claims

1. Claims 1-5, 8-17, 19-25, 31, 33 and 34 are allowed.

2. The following is an examiner's statement of reasons for allowance:

Regarding **claims 1, 12, 13, 19, 20 and 31**, in combination with other limitations of the claims, the prior art of record fails to disclose or specifically suggested wherein in response to a first signal, an indicator of a first device and an alarm of a second device activate to alert the user, wherein a first message-indicating device and a communication device are separate devices and deactivating said indicator upon acknowledgement of a receipt of a communication by said user.
