DETAILED ACTION

Allowable Subject Matter

1. Claims 1-4, 7, 10-12, 14, 15, and 18 are allowed.

2. The following is an examiner's statement of reasons for allowance: None of the references either singularly or in combination teach or fairly suggest a method and apparatus for controlling a cursor in a computer comprising a cursor control apparatus, a piezo-electric tactile feedback apparatus, a driver circuit coupled to the tactile feedback apparatus, a suppression circuit coupled to the computer, the cursor control apparatus, the suppression circuit adapted to receive an input signal generated by the computer and deactivate the cursor control apparatus, a switch circuit connected to the computer and between the driver circuit, the suppression circuit, and the piezo-electric tactile feedback apparatus, and deactivating the operation of the cursor control apparatus in response to the suppression circuit sensing the input signal. Specifically Rosenberg and Barber teach the method an apparatus for a cursor control apparatus using a tactile feedback device wherein suppression of the cursor control is carried out through usage of all of the claimed elements except the switch circuit. The suppression system of Rosenberg is carried out in the local microprocessor as opposed to the usage of a switch circuit as claimed. Therefore the claims are allowable over the prior art of record.
