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#### **DETAILED ACTION**

### Priority

1. Receipt is acknowledged of papers submitted under 35 U.S.C. 119(a)-(d), which papers have been placed of record in the file.

## Claim Rejections - 35 USC § 102

2. The following is a quotation of the appropriate paragraphs of 35 U.S.C. 102 that form the basis for the rejections under this section made in this Office action:

A person shall be entitled to a patent unless -

- (b) the invention was patented or described in a printed publication in this or a foreign country or in public use or on sale in this country, more than one year prior to the date of application for patent in the United States.
- 3. Claims 1-6 are rejected under 35 U.S.C. 102(e) as being anticipated by Haghiri-Tehrani, US Patent No. 5,880,934.

Haghiri-Tehrani discloses a data carrier having separately provided integrated circuit and induction coil comprising: a data carrier 1 having card body 2 with coil 7 disposed thereon and connected electroconductively with module 6, the module 6 includes at least one integrated circuit 4 with two leads which are connected electroconductively with contact elements 5 of the module, the card body 2 includes upper and lower cover layers 10 as well as at least one inner card layer 11 having suitable opening 3 for receiving the module, the coil leads 8 are positioned so as to be disposed directly opposite contact. The card body is formed of plastic (see figures 2, 4, and 4; col. 3, line 14+ and col. 4, line 7+).

#### Conclusion

4. The prior art made of record and not relied upon is considered pertinent to applicant's disclosure. Kreft, US Patent No. 5,773,812, discloses a chip card capable of contact and

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noncontact operation. Mundigl et al, US Patent No. 5,809,623, disclose a method for producing a smart card module for contactless smart cards. Fischer et al, US Patent No. 5,969,951, disclose a method for manufacturing a chip card. Reiner et al, US patent No. 6,321,993, disclose a data carrier having an implanted module based on a metal lead frame.
