Reasons for Allowance

- 1. Claims 1-5, 8-12 and 15-16 are allowed.
- 2. The following is an examiner's statement of reasons for allowance:

While Thomas (U.S. Patent Application Publication No. 2003/0061335) discloses a computerized power management control system includes a virtual modular relay device for providing input and output data to and from an actual modular relay device. The virtual modular relay device includes a wizard that allows user to generate the virtual modular relay device by selecting from template and plurality of functions provided by the actual modular relay device. Thomas does not teach at least one of the switchgear cabinet monitoring and control devices and the management device each has an evaluation stage by which automatically issued status changes of a switchgear cabinet are selected in accordance with a decision criteria; and other limitations related to these features in combination with the remaining elements and features of the claimed invention.

And Murphy (U.S. Patent No. 5,768,148) discloses a utility for rapid development of three dimensional representations of electrical distribution switchgear. The system includes a dynamic data exchange (DDE) server acted as a communication protocol that allows external programs to access power management data in a Microsoft Windows environment. The DDE server can poll the operating device for reporting the status as dead or active. Murphy does not teach each of a switchgear cabinet monitor and control device and the management device are equipped with an evaluation stage with decision criteria, and other limitations related to these features in combination with the remaining elements and features of the claimed invention.

cabinet monitoring and control arrangement having all the claimed features of applicant's instant

invention, specifically including: at least one of the switchgear cabinet monitoring and control

devices and the management device each has an evaluation stage by which automatically issued

status changes of a switchgear cabinet are selected in accordance with a decision criteria. Also,

there is no motivation to combine the Thomas reference with the Murphy reference to meet these

limitations. It is for these reasons that applicant's invention defines over the prior art of record.
